Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Entering the Second Sunday of Advent, we hear from the preaching of St. John the Baptist in today's Gospel about how to prepare the way for the coming of the Lord: "Every valley shall



be filled, every mountain and hill shall be made low, the winding roads shall be made straight, and the rough ways shall be made smooth". In order to celebrate Christmas, the Birth of Christ meaningfully, we too need to heed to these urging words of St. John the Baptist. Unlike the time of St. John the Baptist, the chosen people were longing for the Messiah to come into the world to save them and lead them to his Kingdom. We are however longing for the "rebirth" of Jesus, not in the world, but in our hearts. Since for some, Jesus has been buried in the depths of the valleys of greed, lust, hatred, resentment and worldly allurements. For some, Jesus has been pushed down to the bottom of the mountains and hills of ego "I and mine", and arrogance and pride of self-righteousness. For some, Jesus has been lost in the winding roads of unfaithfulness, maliciousness, and manipulation. For some, Jesus has been mistreated by the rough ways of impatience, unkindness, selfishness, and insensitivity. Jesus will not come alive or return to those hearts that are not well prepared. Let the valleys of our hearts be filled with the desire for the everlasting things above and the love of our neighbor. Let the mountains and hills of our egos and self righteousness be decreased and God's will, words and commandments be increased. Let the winding roads of our words and actions be straightened by integrity, single minded, and truthfulness as well as the rough ways of our personality must be made smooth by recognizing and respecting the dignity, the image and likeness of God in others. -Fr. 






Restoration of St. John Vianney Stained Glass Windows




