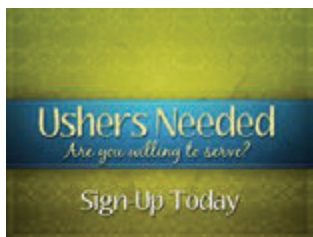

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



In the Second Reading today, St. Paul allegorically used the human body to describe the unique roles, the interaction, and interdependence of the members of the Mystical Body of Christ, the Church: “Now the body is not a single part, but many.... The eye cannot say to the hand, I do not need you, nor again the head to the feet, I do not need you.... If one part suffers, all the parts suffer with it; if one part is honored, all the parts share its joy.” As one Church, one Body, One in Christ, each member of the Body of Christ needs each other for the sake of salvation. As part of the Mystical Body, we may live without each other’s support or loving care; but certainly we cannot live without others’ prayers. No one can go to heaven by his or her effort alone, we need prayers from each other to help us get into heaven as Jesus said: “When two or three of you gather in my name and pray, I will be in your midst”. Whenever we gather together to pray, in the celebration of the Eucharist or any liturgical celebrations, God will be among us to receive our prayers. The prayers offered would benefit every “part of the Body” even if some of the “parts of the Body” are not present. Therefore, attending Mass or attending any public prayer is an act of charity, it benefits ourselves and all members of the “Body”. In the mean time, gathering together to pray only is not enough, our prayers need to be accompanied with our own sacrifices as an expression of our love in “action” for God and His people. As the Church, the Body of Christ, is where we receive salvation and grace. Our parish is part of this whole Church where we belong, unite, and gather together to pray and to celebrate the Sacraments. Where we contribute, and offer our time, talents, and treasure to build up and sustain the means for ourselves and for our brothers and sisters to worship. Where we need each other’s prayers, helping hand, and support. We need every member of the “Mystical Body of Christ” to help build up the “Body” of Christ, to contribute and to sacrifice for the sake of the whole “Body” as we journey together, suffer together, rejoice together, and go to heaven together. - *Fr.
