Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



From the beginning of the divine plan of salvation, which is during the Old Testament period, God gave the Ten Commandments to the chosen people through Moses as moral guidelines for them to follow. The Ten Commandments were given to keep the people from not committing sins: “You shall not kill, steal, commit adultery, etc.” However, when Jesus came during the New Testament period, he perfected the Ten Commandments in the Old Testament by adding and teaching the “eight new commandments”, the Beatitudes, which were taught by Jesus in today’s Gospel. Unlike the Ten Commandments: “You shall not do...”, the Beatitudes command: “Blessed are those who do...”. The Ten Commandments discourage the people not to sin; whereas the Beatitudes encourage the people to be more actively living their faith by following the ways of the Beatitudes which lead to “perfection, holiness, or righteousness” in the eye of God. Indeed, as disciples of Christ and the members of His Body, the Church, we should not just be passively following Jesus and inactively involved in the Church. Just like a member of a family, one should not just: “don’t kill, steal, or commit adultery...” against any members of the family; but rather one should be more actively caring, loving, and sacrificing for his or her loved ones as well. If we just live our faith by keeping the Ten Commandments alone, then we are not “qualified” to be with God for all eternity in heaven because not committing sin or violating the Ten Commandments, is just fulfilling our moral obligation and does not make us “perfect, holy, or righteous”, therefore, “your reward will not be great in heaven or the Kingdom of God will not be yours”. Jesus does not expect us to live the whole Beatitudes in our lives, which is not easy or even possible due to our human weakness and sinfulness; however it does not mean that we can not live at least one in our lives. Let each one of us pick one of the Beatitudes and try to live it faithfully so that: “the Kingdom of God will be yours”. - *Fr. Joe Pham*

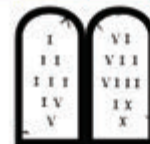

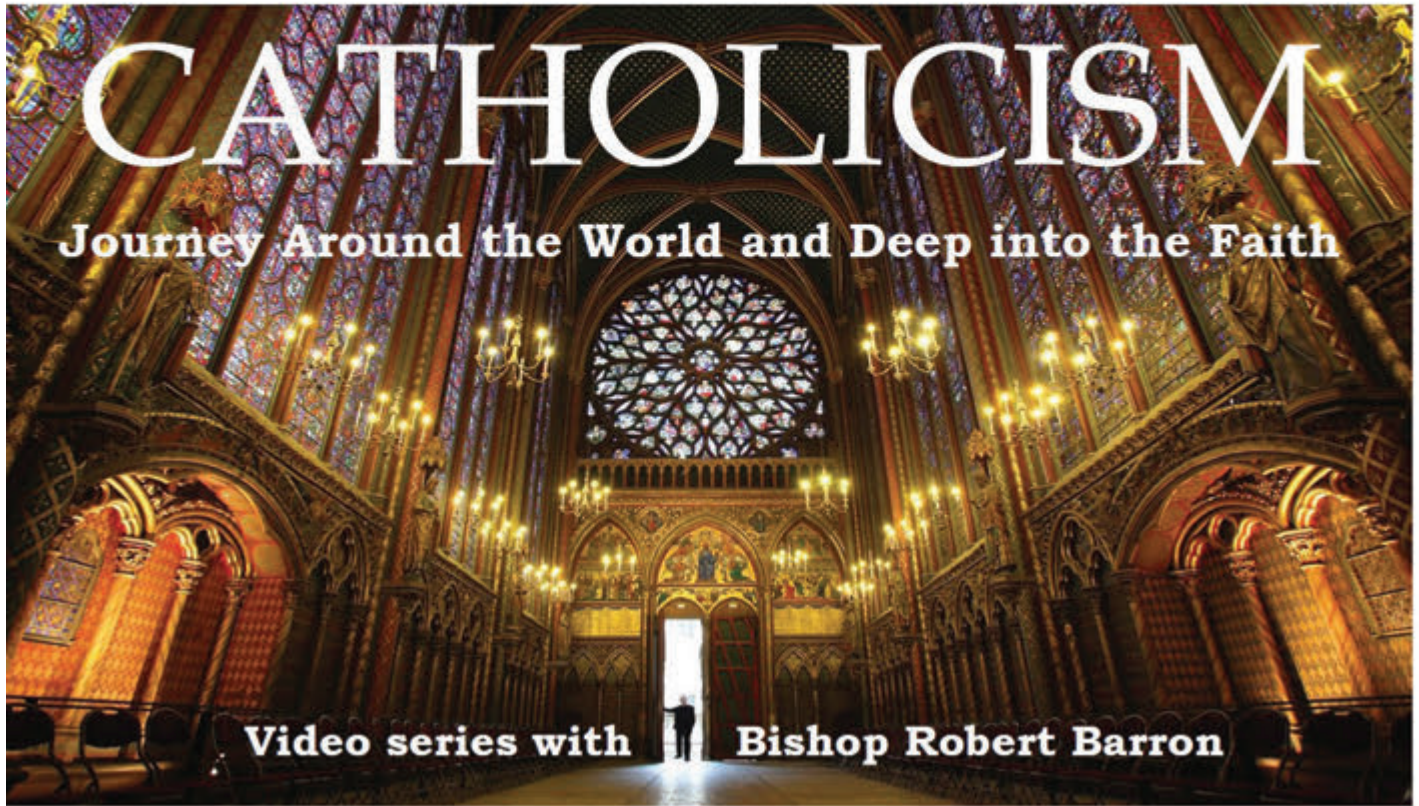
