Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Whenever we say “this person” is good, it is not simply because he or she doesn’t do any bad; but rather that person must do something good in order to be called good. In the same way in order to be called good and faithful disciples of Christ, we do not just avoid doing bad things or sinning but we should also do whatever Jesus commands us to do as well: “To you who hear I say, love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.” said Jesus in today’s Gospel. Therefore; in order to be called good and faithful children and servants of God, we must go above and beyond our selfishness and even act against our sinful nature. Our selfishness and sinful nature tell us to love those who love us and to do good to those who do good to us. However, what credit and what good is that? As Jesus said: “For if you love those who love you, what credit is that to you? Even sinners love those who love them. And if you do good to those who do good to you, what credit is that to you? Even sinners do the same.” As faithful followers of Christ, we are called to change, to be different, to be the salt of the earth, to be Christ-like to others even to our enemies. Only in this way, we would be true to our new identity as children of God and faithful to our entrusted divine mission as disciples of Christ on earth. Jesus asks us to love your enemies because we once were enemies of God, to do good to those who hate you and curse you because we once hated and cursed Jesus when he was nailed on the cross. Therefore, this is not too much to ask of us, but rather we just repay what we owe God. Also, Jesus does not ask us to do something beyond our ability. When he said “love your enemies”, it doesn’t mean “hug your enemies or kiss your enemies” but rather don’t hate them, don’t pursue retribution, don’t hold resentment against them. In the meantime, Jesus asks us to pray for them, pray for their change of heart, for their conversion, for their repentance. With the help of the Holy Spirit, beginning today, let us forgive and pray for our enemies so that they would come to know that we are the disciples of Jesus Christ.- *Fr. Joe Pham*

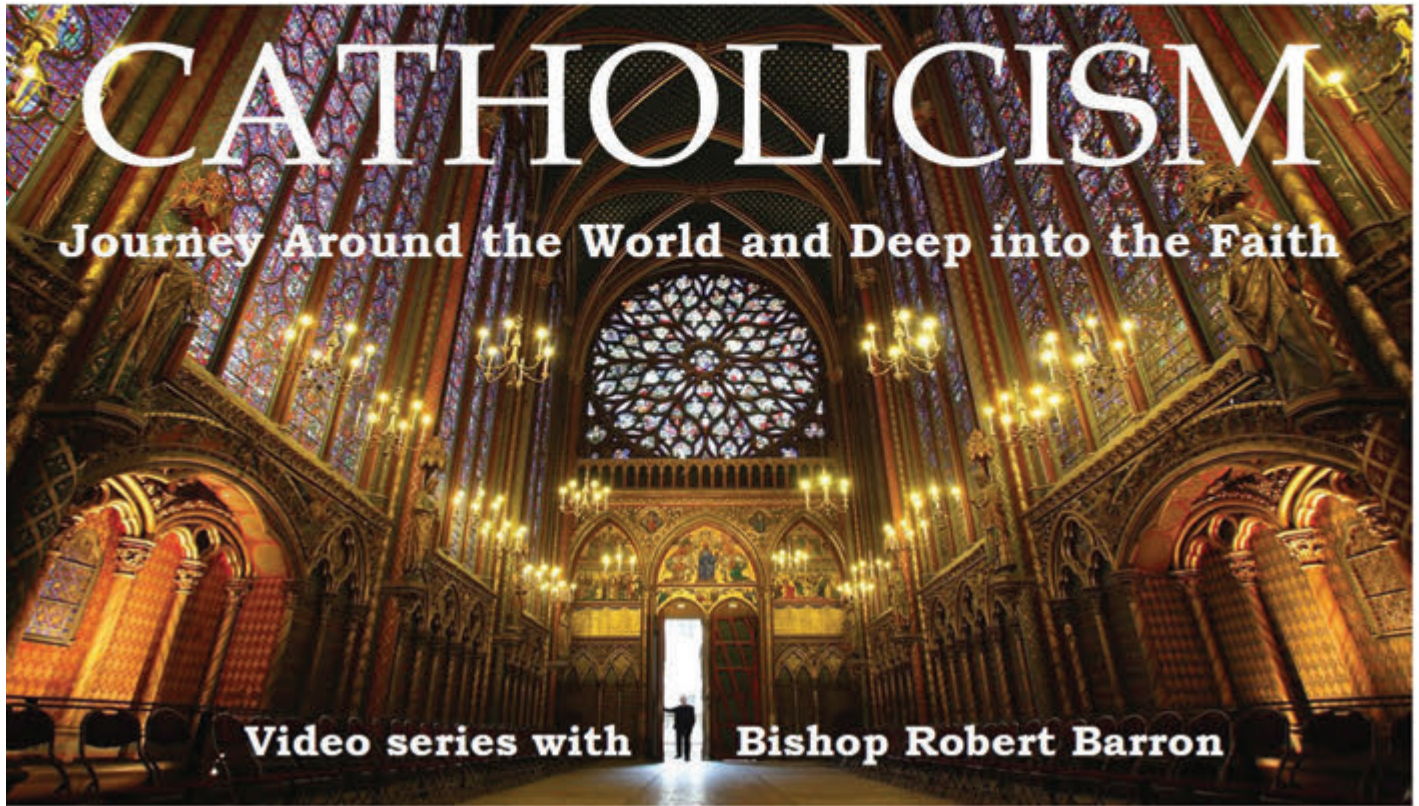
