#### Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we enter the First Week of Lent, the Gospel presents us the scene of the mind battle between Jesus and Satan, right and wrong, good and evil, light and darkness. Satan tried to persuade Jesus from not using the way of the cross to redeem humanity; but rather using the way of "worldly allurements to override" the sins of humanity. As the tempter tempted Jesus: "If you are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread." However, Jesus responded: "One does not live on bread alone". Jesus was seeking the redemption of souls; whereas Satan was seeking the redemption of the body. Jesus was looking at the fulfillment for the deepest longing of the human heart; whereas Satan was looking at the temporary satisfaction of the "belly". Jesus was planning something eternal for humanity; whereas Satan was planning something temporal and destructive. Everyday we struggle with the same temptation like Jesus': the battle of right and wrong, good and evil, following Jesus our Savior or Satan the deceiver, to choose eternal or temporal, which is here today and gone tomorrow. As deceiver, Satan paints a "picture full of worldly illusive glory and eternal fatal attractions" in our minds in order to trap us into eternal damnation with him. Like Jesus, the tempter tries to tempt us to turn away from spiritual need and focus only on carnal need. Unfortunately, many people are easily falling into this tempted deception. Let us use this Lenten Season to focus on our eternal spiritual life and seek the means of prayers, sacrifices, charitable work, and ultimately the Sacrament of reconciliation to fulfill them. Let us not be deceived by Satan about the carnal fulfillment of this world because the truth is that the longings in our hearts are eternal and all earthly things are finite; thus finite things are impossible to fulfill. Let us use this Season of Lent to look for the "Bread of Life" so that our hearts will never be "hungry" again. - Fr. Joe Pham

Mary Immaculate, who first received the Gospel, pray for us. Amen






