**Fasting** - All persons 18 years of age and older, up to and including their 59th birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday**, while the other two meals are to be light.

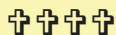

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Beginning this Wednesday, the whole Church will enter the Season of Lent as a preparation for Holy Week and Easter. The Lenten Season is so sacred and profound, it directs our minds and hearts to the depth of God's love for humanity. It reminds us of the death of the Creator for His creatures, the sinless became sinners, the condemned were redeemed, and the power of death was defeated by the power of love. For the next six weeks, we are called to be in touch with God through our sacrifices, prayers, and charitable works, we are called to deepen our relationship with God by recalling and reflecting God's unconditional love and his infinite mercy in our lives. It is also a time for us to be in touch with our own weaknesses and sinfulness as well. The symbol of ashes administered on our foreheads on Ash Wednesday reminds us that "you are dust and to dust you shall return"; therefore turn away from death and be faithful to the Gospel of life. Remember the words of Jesus: "Every sin can be forgiven except the sin against the Holy Spirit". The sin against the Holy Spirit is the failure to admit one's own sinfulness which leads the person to reject God's mercy and forgiveness; therefore this sin cannot be forgiven. In order to live this Lenten Season meaningfully and effectively, let us humbly recognize our failures and sinfulness before our merciful God and take advantage of this Penitential Season to return to God's love by turning away from sin rather than from "sweets or desserts", giving up a heart full of resentment, hatred, indifference, lust, and greed rather than "bad habits", in the mean time, being more actively involved in the work of charity rather than just reciting many "long prayers". Let us take advantage of this Sacred and Holy Season to show our love for Christ by being more compassionate, loving, caring, and forgiving rather than just fasting and not eating meat on Fridays. Let us follow Jesus' footsteps on the "sacrificial road" to Calvary so that we might rise with him on Easter.- *Fr. Joe Pham*

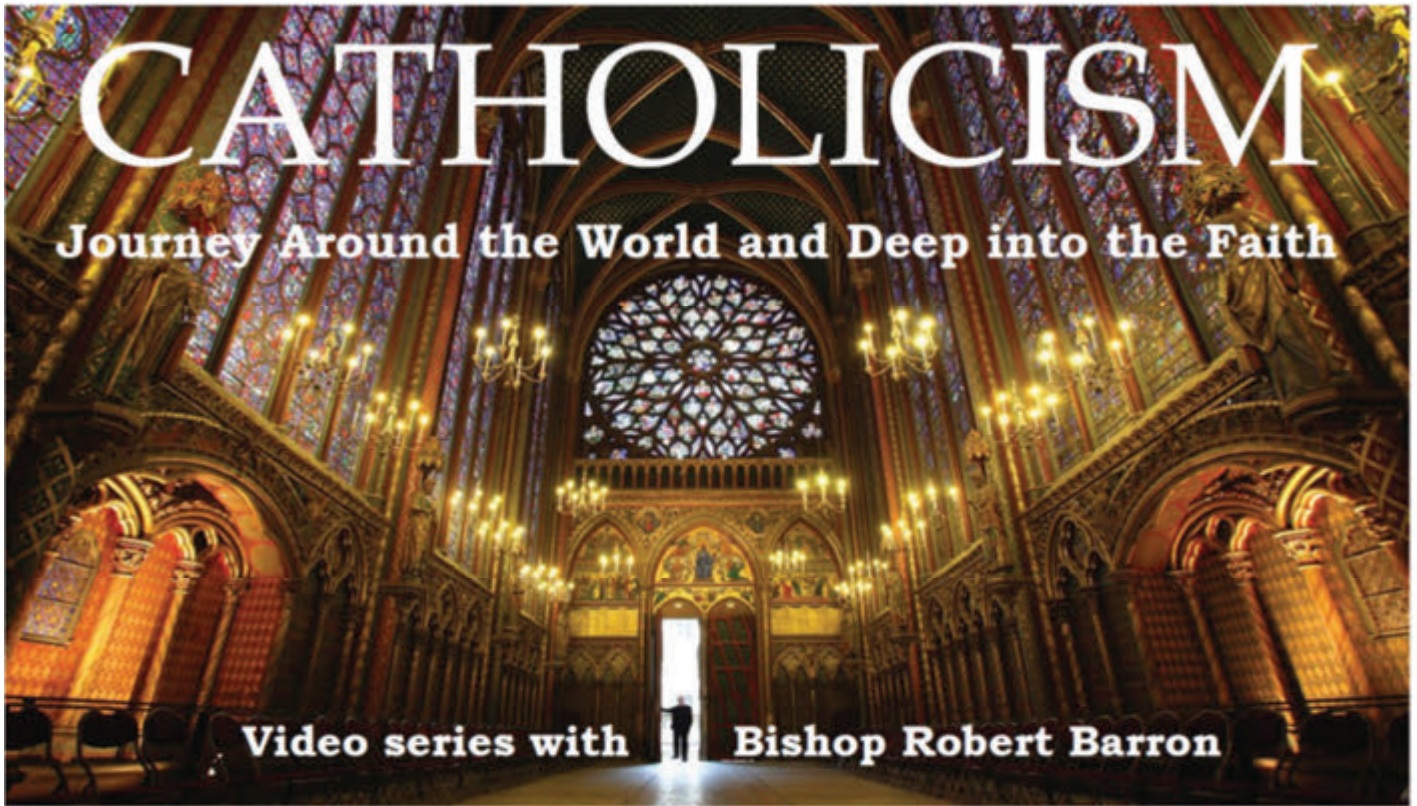
