



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Everyday we say the word õloveö so many times to God, to our loved ones, and others. We like to think about love, talk about love, and use the word õloveö=but how often we õdo loveö or put it into a concrete action. In today & Gospel, Jesus again appeared to his disciples for the third time and this time he asked Peter three questions regarding õloveö. Three times Jesus asked Peter õDo you love me?ö, three times Peter answered õyesö, and three times Jesus told him õfeed my lambs and tend my sheepö. When saying õyes, I love you Jesusö, Peter was asked to manifest his love in action by taking care of Godøs people, feeding them. In this way, Peterøs sin of denial would be forgiven him since love cancels out a multitude of sins. In the same way, if we want our sins to be forgiven, we must do the same. Just like sin separates us from God, love reconciles and reunites us with God. Every day we have so many opportunities to õdo loveö for God through our loved ones and others. Everyday we may say to Jesus õI love youö by living the õdefinition of loveö given by St. Paul: õLove is patient and kind, it is not jealous or conceited or proud, love is not ill mannered or selfish or irritable, love does not keep record of wrongs, love is not happy with evil, but is happy with the truth. Love never gives up, and its faith, hope, and patience never fail.ö (1Cor. 13:4-7). As followers of the Risen Christ, we are Easter people who were redeemed from eternal death and brought back to eternal life by the Risen Christ. Just like Peter, Jesus gives us a second chance to affirm our true love for him by õdoing loveö for our brothers and sisters beginning with those of our loved ones: õtake care them, feed themö. -Fr. KENOSIS PRISON MINISTRY

We would like to thank all those who wrote letters of encouragement, made posters, and prayed for the inmates this past weekend at our retreat behind the walls at New Jersey State Prison in Trenton. Sixty one inmates made the retreat. They heard talks and personal witness from 18 Christian men from different faith traditions, who put away their religious differences, finding õCommon Groundö, which is the love of Jesus Christ for all peoples, sharing this message with the inmates. The weekend was filled with: talks, meditations, music, singing, laughter, emphasis on Saturday evening of extending FOR-GIVENESS...to those that they offended and to those who offended them. This was done with the help of three clergy Spiritual Advisors. The meaning of Kenosis is from the Greek word to empty. This is found in the letter to the Philippians 2:6-11, where Jesus emptied himself and became a servant to us. The inmates were able to empty all their transgressions, fears, and sins, giving them over to Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Sunday, ended the retreat with all the new Kenosis brothers in Christ receiving a Bible and a Certificate of Recognition, with these words - oChrist is counting on you - and I am counting on Christö. Amen, Hallelujah!
