Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



At the threshold of Holy Week, the summit of our faith, the Week that the whole Church solemnly commemorates the Paschal Mystery: Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection, we celebrate Palm Sunday today as a commemoration of Jesus's glorious entry into Jerusalem to accomplish his mission entrusted to him by his heavenly Father.

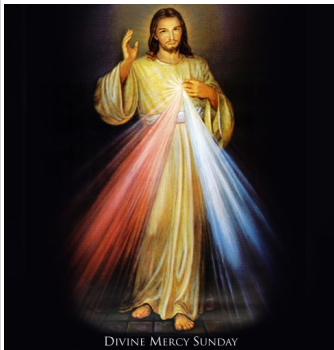
Prophetically, the people praised and glorified him as a "Victorious King" who would liberate them from the Romans' oppression. However, when realizing Jesus was not doing what they thought, they immediately turned against him by screaming "crucify him, crucify him". "Crucify him" because Jesus did not do what they wanted, they wanted a "temporary" solution but Jesus wanted a "permanent" solution, they wanted liberation for their own people but Jesus wanted liberation for all of humanity. The same crowd who glorified Jesus, a few days later, crucified him.

Today we are no better than those people, we praise, glorify, and honor Jesus as our Savior every time we gather around the Table of the Eucharist. However, when returning to our daily lives, we often crucify him by the way we live our lives and the way we treat others. Holy Week is an opportunity and a blessing for us to take part in Christ's Passion, to hang our sins on his cross, so that, through Jesus's redemptive sacrifice on Calvary, we would be pardoned.

Jesus invites each one of us as his children come to his Last Supper on Holy Thursday to share his Body and Blood of eternal life, he invites us to his crucifixion on Good Friday to stand at the foot of his Cross to receive his outpouring mercy and forgiveness, also he invites us to keep vigil at his Tomb on Saturday Easter Vigil to witness his Resurrection.

Can you come to be with Jesus on these Holy Days? Would you like to come to these Three Days to ask Jesus: "Remember me when you come into your kingdom?" -*Fr. Joe Pham*
