





Family Prayer Crucifix for Vocations

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

This Sunday we celebrate the Second Sunday of Easter called Sunday of the Divine Mercy. Today's Gospel tells us that, after the resurrection, the Risen Christ appeared to his disciples, everyone was present and saw the Risen Christ except Thomas. The missing Thomas did not happen by chance but rather it was God's providential plan. Indeed the doubting Thomas is a "living witness" of the Risen Christ for doubting generations to come. Thomas was told by his fellowmen that Jesus came back to life and appeared to them; but he did not believe it, he demanded seeing and touching in order to believe "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nail marks and put my hands into his side, I will not believe." Thomas' demanding proof of Jesus' resurrection is providentially serving a two fold-purpose: proof of the resurrection of Jesus Christ and of his Divine Mercy for humanity. Surprisingly, when the Risen Christ appeared again and invited doubting Thomas to touch him, instead of touching his scars and nail marks as he demanded, Thomas cried out from the depth of his heart: "My Lord and my God". For Thomas, the evidence of the resurrection of Jesus Christ was so overwhelming: "Jesus is living with the same physical body, his nail marks and scars are still there, speaking with the same caring and gentle tone etc." Also, by showing his nail marks and scar from his side, Jesus wanted Thomas, and indeed all future generations, to recognize these signs as his Divine Mercy for humanity. As the Incarnation was an "act of Divine Mercy", by mercy Jesus took upon himself our human nature and became man which was later manifested in his nail marks and scar. Like Thomas, Jesus invites us to come to the Eucharistic Table to touch his

nail marks and scar and believe, to recognize and receive his Divine Mercy and be saved. -Fr. Joe Pham
