

# **KENOSIS PRISON MINISTRY**


We would like to thank all those who wrote letters of encouragement, made posters, and prayed for the inmates this past weekend at our retreat behind the walls at New Jersey State Prison in Trenton. Sixty one inmates made the retreat. They heard talks and personal witness from 18 Christian men from different faith traditions, who put away their religious differences, finding "Common Ground", which is the love of Jesus Christ for all peoples, sharing this message with the inmates. The weekend was filled with: talks, meditations, music, singing, laughter, emphasis on Saturday evening of extending FOR-GIVENESS...to those that they offended and to those who offended them. This was done with the help of three clergy Spiritual Advisors. The meaning of Kenosis is from the Greek word to empty. This is found in the letter to the Philippians 2:6-11, where Jesus emptied himself and became a servant to us. The inmates were able to empty all their transgressions, fears, and sins, giving them over to Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Sunday, ended the retreat with all the new Kenosis brothers in Christ receiving a Bible and a Certificate of Recognition, with these words - "Christ is counting on you - and I am counting on Christ". Amen, Hallelujah!
