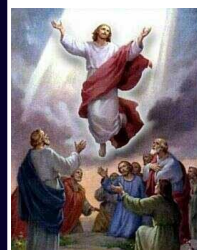

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



On Thursday this week, with the whole Church we will joyfully celebrate the Ascension of the Lord into heaven. However, what the Ascension of the Lord means because Jesus has never left heaven even when he came down on earth. For all eternity his “Divine Godhead” has always been in heaven, so where did he ascend? First of all, since the Incarnation, Jesus united himself to us by taking upon himself our human nature in order to suffer and die for our sins. So, after the resurrection, the God-made Man Jesus ascended into heaven not for his sake but rather for our own sake. He ascended into heaven in order to unite his Mystical Body, the Church and all her members, to God the “Trinitarian Family” so that where the Head is the whole Body will follow. Jesus is the mediator between God and man, he came down to unite himself to humanity in order to redeem us and, after the resurrection, he ascended into heaven in order to unite us to God the Father and the Holy Spirit. The Ascension of the Lord is indeed a completion of the act of redemption. 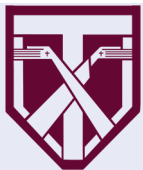

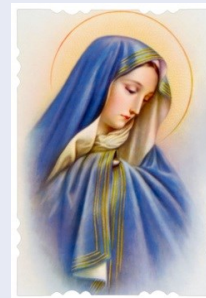

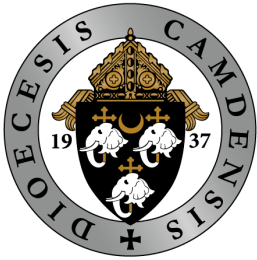
