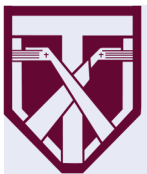
Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Today we celebrate the mystery of the Blessed Holy Trinity, the essence of our faith. Through Jesus' revelation, we are able to know about the fact of the nature of the Blessed Trinity: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." (Matt 28:19). There are three distinct Persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit; but only One God and all are equal in power. 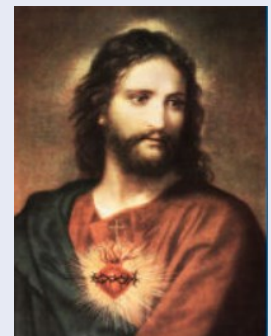
Meet Mrs. Kathie Benfield—Middle School Social Studies

ST. MARGARET & ST. JOHN VIANNEY CHURCHES PROJECT UPDATE

Dear Parishioners,

I would like to inform you about some changes regarding St. Margaret Church renovations. On January 30th, 2019, everyone was invited to attend the meeting to discuss the renovations of St. Margaret Church. At the meeting, we decided to refurbish the existing pews, replace the kneelers, the deteriorating carpets in the Church and Chapel, the main wooden Sanctuary with marble as well as the center aisle and the vestibule with porcelain floor tile and add seat cushions on the pews. The total cost for this project is **\$196,900.00**.

However, due to not achieving our Catholic Strong Goal, I called for a special meeting on May 28th, 2019 which included the Parish and Finance Councils as well as the Building and Grounds Committee to reconsider the cost of this project. After carefully reviewing the cost of the project and the reality of the Catholic Strong fund, they recommended **cutting back the unnecessary costs which were the pew cushions, the Sanctuary marble floor, and the porcelain floor tile in the center aisle.** Therefore, we will now proceed with refurbishing the pews, replacing the kneelers, carpeting the whole Church, Chapel, porcelain tile the vestibule floor, and repairing and refurbishing the wooden Sanctuary floor. This plan will cost **\$145,965.00**.

This summer we hope to accomplish these much needed repaired-projects:

- 1- Paving St. John Vianney parking lot @ a cost of \$31,000.00
- 2- Replacing St. John Vianney Church carpet @ a cost of \$20,000.00
- 3- St. Margaret Church interior Renovations @ a cost of \$145,965.00

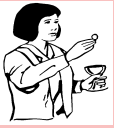

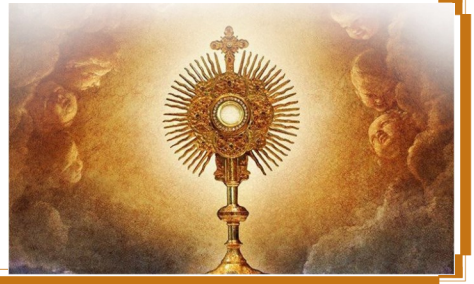

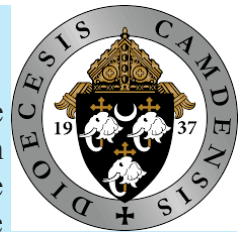

New Jersey Independent Victims Compensation Program to open June 15

As had been announced in February of this year, the Diocese of Camden – along with the other Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey – has established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest of the Diocese. The IVCP will be open to claims beginning June 15



The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros. Mr. Feinberg was the plan administrator for the federal 9/11 victim compensation program, as well as the Boston Marathon bombing compensation program.

The IVCP will handle the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and will operate independently of the Diocese or any church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP will have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims – no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to www.njdiocesesivcp.com and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim.

The IVCP is a continuation of the goals set out by Bishop Dennis Sullivan in his February 16, 2019 letter to the people of the Diocese of Camden. “We pray that God will continue to look after the victims and survivors of the priest sex abuse scandal. We ask that He give them hope, provide them with healing and bring comfort to their wounded souls.”

Bishop Sullivan strongly encourages anyone who was sexually victimized by a priest of the Diocese to participate in the IVCP, and has asked that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to contact them so that they are aware of the IVCP and can participate in it.

PRO LIFE/ABORTION FACTS
