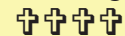

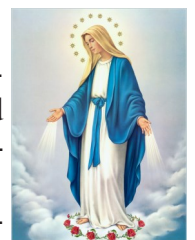

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Today, with joyful spirit, the whole Church celebrates her manifestation to the world. As the Church was born at the moment of blood and water coming out from the side of the crucified Jesus on Good Friday, at Pentecost, the Church was manifested to the whole world by the descending of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles. The Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles in the form of fire which signified the intensive burning love of God in them. The love that empowered them to overcome fear and also enabled them to proclaim the Good News of salvation for humanity gained by the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. It was the Holy Spirit who manifested the Church to the whole world by enabling the Apostles to speak the languages that everyone could understand. The Pentecostal event opened a new chapter and new understanding of the divine plan for human salvation. Salvation now is not only granted for the chosen people, Israelites, but it is also for everyone who believes and accepts Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. Therefore, the Pentecostal event is truly a fulfilment of God's promise to Abraham: "Your descendants will be like stars in the sky". We are now also considered descendants of Abraham, the chosen people, the people being set apart through Baptism, not by water, but by the Holy Spirit. Our sins are washed away not by the blood of animal sacrifices but by the blood of the Lamb of God, Jesus Christ. Our Lord Jesus did not abandon us after his ascension to the Father; he sent the Holy Spirit at Pentecost as our Advocate to defend us, protect us from falling away, and ultimately to sanctify us and remind us of all that Jesus said and did: "I have told you this while I am with you. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit that the Father will send in my name, he will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." (John 14:25-27). Come Holy Spirit to strengthen our faith, hope, and love in and for God. Come Holy Spirit to enable us to speak the language of love and forgiveness, the language of compassion and charity, the language that everyone can understand.

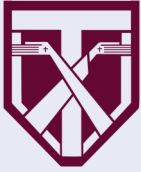

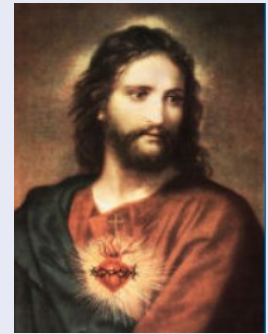

The Carnival may be over but we still have a lot of work to do (and many bills to pay) before we know how well the carnival did. We will update you on how well we did later in the summer.

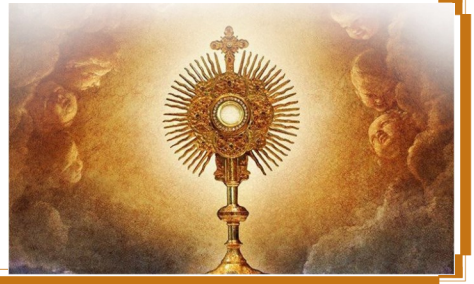

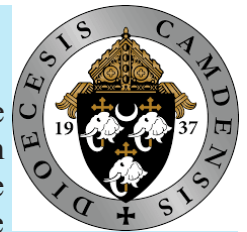

New Jersey Independent Victims Compensation Program to open June 15

As had been announced in February of this year, the Diocese of Camden – along with the other Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey – has established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest of the Diocese. The IVCP will be open to claims beginning June 15



The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros. Mr. Feinberg was the plan administrator for the federal 9/11 victim compensation program, as well as the Boston Marathon bombing compensation program.

The IVCP will handle the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and will operate independently of the Diocese or any church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP will have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims – no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to www.njdiocesesivcp.com and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim.

The IVCP is a continuation of the goals set out by Bishop Dennis Sullivan in his February 16, 2019 letter to the people of the Diocese of Camden. “We pray that God will continue to look after the victims and survivors of the priest sex abuse scandal. We ask that He give them hope, provide them with healing and bring comfort to their wounded souls.”

Bishop Sullivan strongly encourages anyone who was sexually victimized by a priest of the Diocese to participate in the IVCP, and has asked that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to contact them so that they are aware of the IVCP and can participate in it.
