Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

Every one of us are familiar with the Gospel today, the story of the Good Samaritan. The Gospel tells us that a scholar of the law asked Jesus: "Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" This man knew the law by heart, he tried to keep every letter of the law but he was still afraid of missing something which would prevent him from achieving eternal life. In responding to his question, Jesus asked him to repeat what was written in the law: "You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your being, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself." Since he himself was so "strict" to the "law", he again asked Jesus to explain specifically "who is considered to be your neighbor". For this reason, Jesus gave the parable of the Good Samaritan. There are three main characters in this parable: the priest, Levite, and Samaritan. For the priest and Levite, both of them were on the way to the temple to perform their priestly duties, and when seeing the robbery victim laying on the side road like a "dead body", they tried to avoid him because they observed the law strictly which banned them from performing priestly duties if they touched "things" considered by the law to be "impure". However, a Samaritan, a pagan who knew nothing about the law, was moved with compassion "poured oil and wine over his wounds and bandaged them. Then he lifted him up on his own animal, took him to an inn, and cared for him". According to the priest and Levite in this story, their religion was "a bunch of ritual and law"; whereas the Samaritan's religion was "pity and compassion". How often do we fall into this "Levitical trap" by keeping the "letter of the law" instead of the "spirit of the law". For such a person, his or her God is the law and not love, a religion to be kept rather than to live. -Fr. Joe Pham



New Jersey Independent Victims Compensation Program

The Diocese of Camden – along with the other Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey – has established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest of the Diocese.

The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros.

The IVCP will handles the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and operates independently of the Diocese or any church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims – no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to www.njdiocesesivcp.com and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim.

Bishop Sullivan strongly encourages anyone who was sexually victimized by a priest of the Diocese to participate in the IVCP, and has asked that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to contact them so that they are aware of the IVCP and can participate in it.




