#### Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Pastor's Desk The Story of Martha and Mary in today's Gospel is a "wake-up call" for all of us. It reminds us of the purpose of our lives and what we should do to achieve that purpose. Martha invited Jesus into her home and was "burdened with much serving"; whereas Mary her sister was sitting and listening to Jesus' teaching. When Martha could not take the "burden of serving" any more, she asked Jesus to tell her sister, Mary, to help her with the serving. However, instead of telling Mary to help her sister, Jesus responded: "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her." Indeed, we are human beings and not "human-doing", we should be concerned more about being with God and the things of heaven rather than "getting earthly things done". Everyday our "living" must be rooted in the love of God and the truths of his teaching, everyday our "doing" must be rooted in prayer and motivated by the love of others. In other words, we must try to balance between our spiritual life and earthly life. When entering Martha's house, Jesus wanted her to benefit from his preaching rather than wanting a good "meal" from her. He wanted her to be concerned and to value the heavenly things over earthly things. He wanted her to know that whatever she was doing on earth must be geared to one thing which was eternal life. Moreover, Martha's problem was that she forgot who she was serving, whom she was preparing the meal for, she was just "doing" for the sake of "doing" and not being conscious of the fact that she was "doing" out of the love for Jesus. If what she was doing was for the love of Jesus, she would not feel so "burdened and anxious" instead she would feel more excited and joyful by serving the one she loved. How often do we feel so "burdened" by taking care of our loved ones? If we "do" it merely for the sake of "doing" then it would certainly become a burden; but if we "do" it out of love, then it would be a joy and pleasure. -Fr. Joe Pham







#### **New Jersey Independent Victims Compensation Program**



dependent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest of the Diocese.

The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros.

The IVCP will handles the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and operates independently of the Diocese or any churchaffiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to www.njdiocesesivcp.com and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim.

Bishop Sullivan strongly encourages anyone who was sexually victimized by a priest of the Diocese to participate in the IVCP, and has asked that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to contact them so that they are aware of the IVCP and can participate in it.
