#### Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

In today's Gospel, Jesus taught his disciples the "Our Father Prayer". Unlike other prayers which are written by human beings: Popes, Bishops, Priests, or Religious, the "Our Father" was spoken, written, by Jesus himself. Since every single word in the "Our Father" came directly from the mouth of Jesus, we should not take this prayer for granted but rather we must pray it with our whole "heart and soul". Very often we just get through the "Our Father" without any reflections of thoughts about the meaning of each word. There are seven petitions in the "Our Father" as we pray:

- 1- Father, your name be hollowed, be glorified, be holy, be praised above others names
- 2- Your kingdom come: your kingdom will be spread, known throughout the whole world, that everyone will accept your kingdom as his/her destiny
- 3- Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven: As you willed the Saints in heaven to be in your eternal loving union, may it be done on earth for all of us as well.
- 4- Give us each day our daily bread: Spiritual and material bread, the bread that nourishes our soul which nurtures and strengthens our faith, hope, and love in and for you and, if you will, our body as well.
- 5- Forgive us our sins as we too should forgive others' debts: We beg you Lord forgive our sins and, at the same time, we ask you to open our hearts to those who sinned against us as well.
- 6- Do not subject us to the final test or lead us not into temptation: We do not ask you to take away temptations from us; but we beg you Lord help us and protect us so that we would not give in into temptations.
- 7- But deliver us from evil: We ask you Lord, with your merciful love and powerful hands, please deliver us from the evil one.

The first three petitions focus on God, the Father. The fourth and fifth petitions pray for our needs both body and soul. And the sixth and seventh petitions pray for our vindication over our daily struggle with temptations and the evil spirit. *-Fr. Joe Pham*

The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros.

The IVCP will handles the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and operates independently of the Diocese or any church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims – no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to <a href="www.njdiocesesivcp.com">www.njdiocesesivcp.com</a> and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim.

Bishop Sullivan strongly encourages anyone who was sexually victimized by a priest of the Diocese to participate in the IVCP, and has asked that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to contact them so that they are aware of the IVCP and can participate in it.
