Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



A couple of things said by Jesus in today's Gospel are really disturbing and hard to accept: "If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciples." Also: "In the same way, anyone of you who does not renounce all his possessions cannot be my disciple." If we take these words literally, then none of us would be qualified to be Jesus' disciples since we love our families so dearly, as well as, the need to have some possessions for the sake of our own lives and the lives of our loved ones.

Indeed, Jesus used these words "hate and renounce" in order to catch the people's attention to something so important. Of course, Jesus wants us to love and care for everyone in our families and to fulfill our obligations and duties as husband and wife, parents and children, brothers and sisters. He also wants us to work hard for material goods in order to feed and support our families, he certainly does not want us to be poor or live in poverty.

However, figuratively Jesus is calling us to be detached from this worldly allurements and attachments. In other words, if anyone who is so attached to "earthly things" cannot be my disciple, also "hating his father and mother..." implies: "Don't let anyone even your loved one be a barrier or an obstacle" to the practice of your faith or to your missionary discipleship. In the meantime, if one is so attached to earthly things, he or she would never have the time or the desire for Sunday Mass even only one hour a week. If one is so attached to this material world, he or she would never have time for "spiritual life" as well as be able to do "charitable work" which is the essential means to salvation. It is a "heavy cross, a burden" to be detached emotionally and physically from our loved ones and from this worldly possession. However, as Jesus said: "Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple". Truly it is considered as a "cross" in this life; but it will be transformed into an "everlasting glory" in the life to come. Fr. Joe Pham.

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

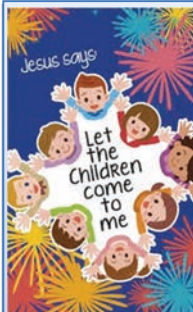

New Jersey Independent Victims Compensation Program



The Diocese of Camden – along with the other Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey – has established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest of the Diocese.

The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros.

The IVCP will handles the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and operates independently of the Diocese or any church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims – no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to www.njdiocesesisivcp.com and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim.

Bishop Sullivan strongly encourages anyone who was sexually victimized by a priest of the Diocese to participate in the IVCP, and has asked that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to contact them so that they are aware of the IVCP and can participate in it.

REPORT SEXUAL ABUSE

An independent, toll-free number has been established by the Diocese of Camden to help callers report cases of sexual abuse by priests, deacons, religious, employees and/or volunteers. Calls are handled by a licensed clinical social worker. In accord with state law, cases of child sexual abuse are reported to the NJ Division of Child Protection and permanency and law enforcement.
