nom the Pastor's Desk

As our nation is observing Labor Day this weekend, we, as Christians, should celebrate it not just as a civil event but also as a religious significance as well. From the beginning of creation,

God intended to create a perfect world with everything in it including humanity; however human beings misused the God-given power of free will therefore sin entered the world and human labor was one of the consequences of this original sin: "Because of what you have done, the ground will be under a curse. You will have to work hard all your life to make it produce enough food for you". (Gen 3:17). However, thanks be to God for his unconditional love and infinite mercy, he sent his only Son, Jesus Christ, to redeem humanity and to reconcile all creation to himself. By this virtual act of the redemption of his Son, God transformed the "curse" of human labor into "blessings". For this reason, our labor now has a redemptive meaning which means our daily labor is a pro-recreation with God, to make this fallen world a better place everyday. We should learn from Jesus Christ's work in the economy of salvation which is both human and divine. His work was human since it involved his human sacrifice and divine because it involved the salvation of souls. By his redemptive work, Jesus also gave to our human labor a twofold meaning as well: human and divine. Working in order to support our human needs and, in the mean time. to "remake" God's creation for the better. Let us thank God for allowing us to be part of his "re-creation". 

The new safe environment training program for adults is **VIRTUS**® Protecting God's Children. This replaces CAP.

If you have never been fingerprinted for the Diocese of Camden and you have never attended a CAP session, you are considered a "first time user."

First time registrants need to go on the Diocese of Camden website click on the VIRTUS link located at the bottom of the website and follow the directions.

If you have been fingerprinted for the Diocese of Camden and/or you have attended a CAP session, you are considered to have an existing account. Contact your parish or school safe environment coordinator who will provide you with instructions.

#### New Jersey Independent Victims Compensation Program

The Diocese of Camden – along with the other Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey – has established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest of the Diocese.



The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros.

The IVCP will handles the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and operates independently of the Diocese or any church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims – no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to <u>www.njdiocesesivcp.com</u> and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim.

Bishop Sullivan strongly encourages anyone who was sexually victimized by a priest of the Diocese to participate in the IVCP, and has asked that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to contact them so that they are aware of the IVCP and can participate in it.
