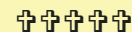

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Today's Gospel is so familiar to all of us, it is also called the Gospel of the "Prodigal Son". The character "father" in this parable signifies God, the Father. The older son signifies those who practice their faith regularly; whereas the younger son signifies those who go astray from their faith. Usually, readers would think that only the younger son needed conversion or a change of heart. However, this parable is indeed intended to teach both "sons". Both of them needed to change their perceptions about the "father" as well as their ways of living out the spirit of their "father". From this parable, we realize that our Father is a merciful God.

Regardless of the "sin" of the younger son, the father was so happy and rejoiced for the return of his astray son. The run-away son was totally wrong by thinking that his father would not welcome him back as his own son but rather as a "hired worker". He truly did not know or understand his father at all. On the other hand, even though the older son did not go astray, he also needs conversion of heart as well. He thought that he was so "righteous" by keeping every "command" from his "strict" father. He believed his father was so strict to the point that he would not even dare to ask his father to slaughter a "goat" to celebrate with his friends. Like the younger son, he was totally wrong, his father was not so "strict" as he perceived. That is why his father said: "My son, you are here with me always; everything I have is yours. Why didn't you ask?" "But now we must celebrate and rejoice, because your brother was dead and has come to life again; he was lost and has been found". This is the "kind" of God we are believing and worshiping. He is the Father of mercy, who is always waiting at the "gate" for those who go astray to return, no matter how sinful they are and how long they have been away. Also, those who practice their faith faithfully should not consider as "enough"; but rather they should take a real look at the way they "practice". Our God does not want us to keep our faith only for the sake of belief; but also: "be merciful as your heavenly Father is merciful". Fr. Joe Pham

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

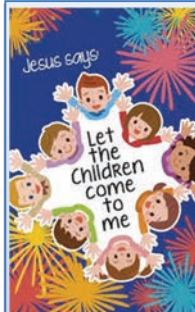

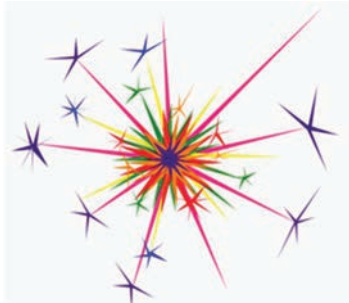

New Jersey Independent Victims Compensation Program



The Diocese of Camden – along with the other Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey – has established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest of the Diocese.

The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros.

The IVCP will handle the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and operates independently of the Diocese or any church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims – no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to www.njdiocesivcp.com and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim.

Bishop Sullivan strongly encourages anyone who was sexually victimized by a priest of the Diocese to participate in the IVCP, and has asked that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to contact them so that they are aware of the IVCP and can participate in it.
