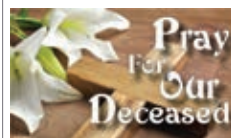

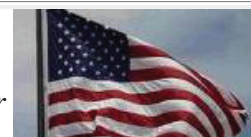

All students from Grades 3 to 7 are welcome to join the Altar Server Ministry.

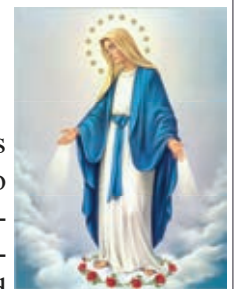

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



This Sunday, October 13 at the 10:00 AM Mass, our Parish will celebrate the Feast Day of one of our patron Saints: St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. St. Margaret was born on July 22, 1647 in Burgundy, France. As a young teenager, she developed a special devotion to the Blessed Sacrament. In 1671 she entered the Visitation Convent and began to experience visions of Christ when she was twenty. In the visions, she had received a series of revelations in which Christ informed her that she was His chosen instrument to spread the devotion of His Sacred Heart, also she was asked that the Feast of the Sacred Heart be established. She died on October 17, 1690 and was canonized in 1920. Seventy five years after her death, the devotion of the Sacred Heart of Jesus was officially recognized and approved by Pope Clement XIII in 1765. In celebrating her Feast, we pray that St. Margaret would inflame in our hearts a burning love and heartfelt gratitude to the Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ, the Heart that was, is, and will be painfully pierced through everyday by the sword of our sins. The Heart that has never been tired of loving and forgiving, the Heart that has never stopped thirsting for astray souls. This Sacred Heart wants to talk “heart to heart” with each one of us in prayers This Sacred Heart wants to be united “heart to heart” to each one of us in the Eucharist. This Sacred Heart wants to lighten all our burdens, and heal us in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Are we willing to talk, to be healed, and to be united “heart to heart” to the Sacred Heart of Christ as St. Margaret Mary Alacoque did? St. Margaret pray for us. *Fr. Joe Pham*

## New Jersey Independent Victims Compensation Program



The Diocese of Camden – along with the other Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey – has established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest of the Diocese.

The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros.

The IVCP will handle the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and operates independently of the Diocese or any church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims – no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to [www.njdiocesesivcp.com](http://www.njdiocesesivcp.com) and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim.

Bishop Sullivan strongly encourages anyone who was sexually victimized by a priest of the Diocese to participate in the IVCP, and has asked that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to contact them so that they are aware of the IVCP and can participate in it.

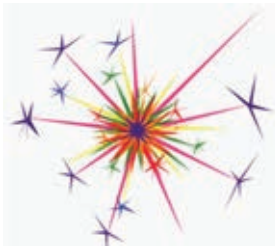
