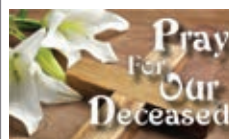

All students from Grades 3 to 7 are welcome to join the Altar Server Ministry.

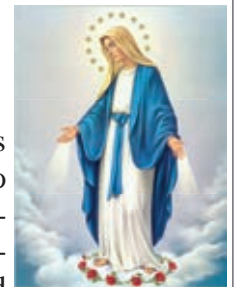

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



In the beginning of today's Gospel, Jesus emphasized the necessity of prayer and, at the end of the Gospel, he seemed "hopelessly" saying: "But when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?"

The purpose of prayer is not making a "grocery" list or telling God what to give; but rather it is about surrender and submission to the divine will as well as uniting one's whole being to God. The question is why pray? Pray because we need protection and direction in the world where everything, even our loved ones can go wrong at any time. Pray because the future is unknown and uncertain to us. Pray because there are so many things that are beyond our human nature and capacity to heal, to change, to fix or to control. There are more rational reasons to pray than not to pray. Jesus wanted us to pray because he knew the limit of our human nature, he knew that only prayer could give us peace, strength, comfort, consolation, and hope in times of trouble, danger, weakness, loss, brokenness, and despair. He knew that only prayer could fix the unfixable, change the unchangeable, heal the unhealable, forgive the unforgivable, and love the unlovable. When surrendering and submitting ourselves to the divine providence, we are letting God take over all our mental, physical, or moral burdens as Jesus said: "Come to me, all you who are weary and find life burdensome, and I will refresh you" (Matt 11:28). Unfortunately, some try to solve their problems on their own capacities and strengths instead of surrendering to God in prayer. However, the more they try, the more they are weary and hopeless due to their human limitation. Some even give up or stop praying if they do not get what they want. This is sad because they ignorantly give up their ultimate hope in the divine power. Let us be in touch with God everyday, let us surrender all our burdens and let God lead us into the way, the truth, and the life. By praying constantly, our faith in God will be strengthened and when Jesus comes he will find "some faith" on earth.

New Jersey Independent Victims Compensation Program



The Diocese of Camden – along with the other Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey – has established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest of the Diocese.

The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros.

The IVCP will handle the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and operates independently of the Diocese or any church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims – no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to www.njdiocesesivcp.com and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim.

Bishop Sullivan strongly encourages anyone who was sexually victimized by a priest of the Diocese to participate in the IVCP, and has asked that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to contact them so that they are aware of the IVCP and can participate in it.

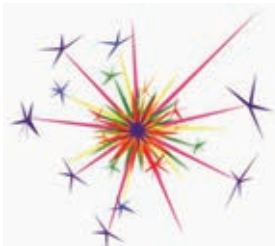

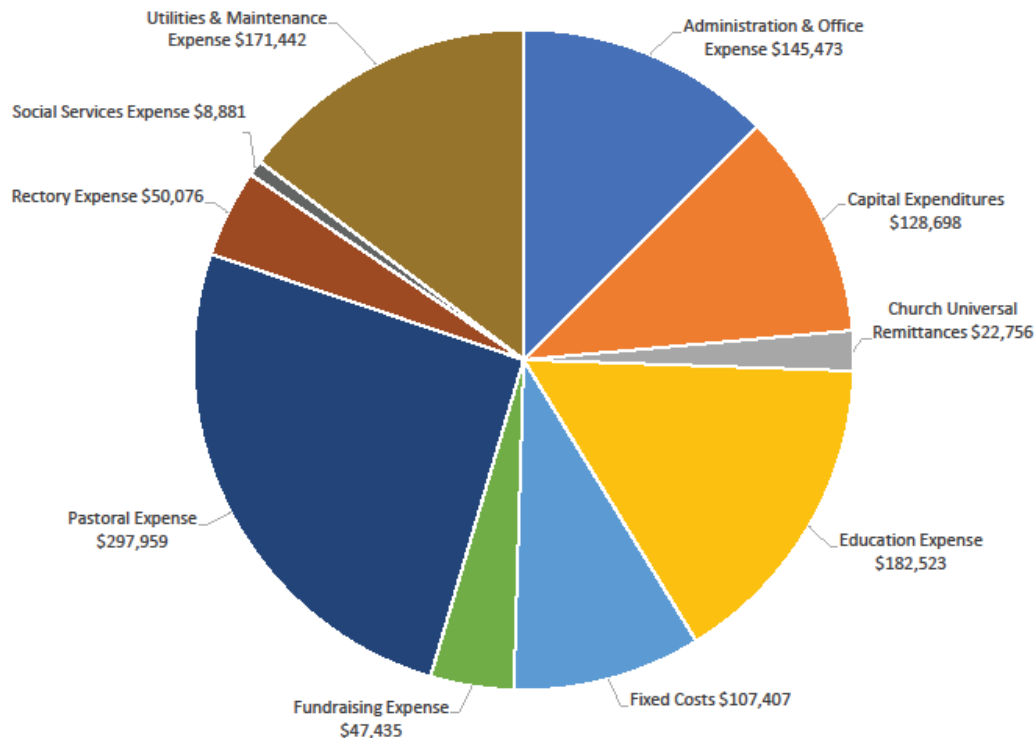
