Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



"If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, be uprooted and planted in the sea, and it would obey you." said Jesus in today's Gospel.

Through Baptism, the "seed" of faith in God, our Creator and Redeemer is planted in our lives. This "seed" of faith would not automatically grow "bigger" or stronger; but rather it needs to be "nourished" everyday in order to grow. Look at the lives of the saints, they nourished their faith through various means: prayer, contemplation, adoration, penance, fasting, acts of charity, sacrifice, perseverance, and patient endurance. The Saints received "equal amounts" of faith like every one of us at baptism; but why was their faith so strong whereas ours' is often weak and even shaken, especially in times of difficulty and trouble. By nourishing their faith with those above means, the Saints were able to see things in this world through the eyes of God. They were able to recognize the divine presence in all worldly events, the divine providence in all situations of life, and the divine will amidst sorrow, suffering, distress, separation, and even in danger of death.

When Jesus said: "If you have faith the size of a mustard seed..." you would be able to move the mulberry tree, he was not exaggerating. Look at the faith of Abraham who still believed that God would make him the father of many even though his only son Isaac was asked to be sacrificed to God. Through faith St. Monica kept praying for 30 years for the conversion of her astray son, St. Augustine. Her faith was able to turn St. Augustine's life around from an unbeliever to believer, a terrible sinner to a great Saint.

We need to have faith in God when living in this unstable world to keep us stable. We need faith as a "weapon" of peace to deal with all uncertainties laying ahead of us. We need faith which will enable us to see things beyond this troubled world, the things that would give us hope when we are hopeless, peace when things seem to be falling apart, and strength when the "flame" of body, mind, and spirit are almost extinguished. *Fr. 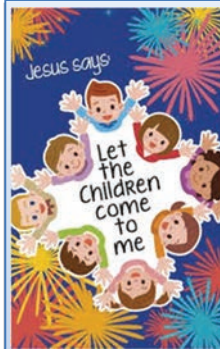

New Jersey Independent Victims Compensation Program



The Diocese of Camden – along with the other Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey – has established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest of the Diocese.

The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros.

The IVCP will handle the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and operates independently of the Diocese or any church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims – no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to www.njdiocesesivcp.com and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim.

Bishop Sullivan strongly encourages anyone who was sexually victimized by a priest of the Diocese to participate in the IVCP, and has asked that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to contact them so that they are aware of the IVCP and can participate in it.

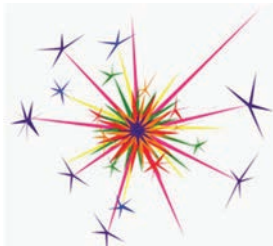

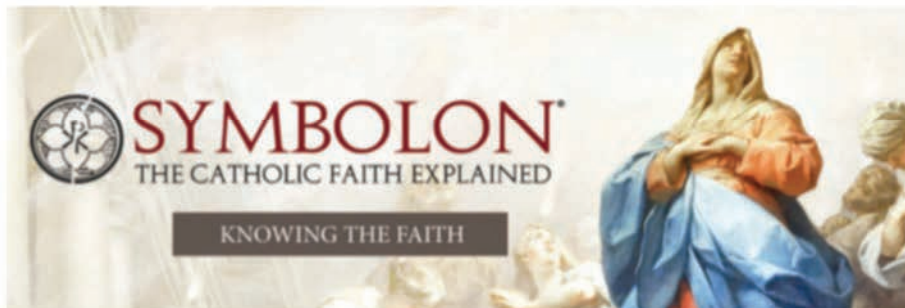
