Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



The story of Zacchaeus in today's Gospel serves as a reminder for all of us; that is, even "a wealthy man" like Zacchaeus who seemed lacking nothing materially, but one thing he could not use money to buy: "To have Jesus in his home". As a wealthy man, Zacchaeus did not lack anything, he could buy anything with his money; but one thing he could not buy was inner peace and eternal happiness. He did not have peace in his heart due to his tax extortion which bothered his conscience. He collected taxes from his own people more than what the Roman emperor demanded so that he could put some in his own pocket. However, he knew that this temporal wealth would not last forever; therefore he was looking for something else. He looked for Jesus. He desired to see Jesus who claimed himself as a Messiah. He climbed on the sycamore tree, to get above and beyond the crowd "the earthly wealth and attraction", so that they would not be an obstacle to his view of Jesus. Like Zacchaeus, we need to look into our hearts and see if we truly have peace or not, to see if something that has bothered our conscience for years, or something that we are longing for which money can not buy. What good is that to have everything in this life but no peace in our conscience? What good is that for one to spend his whole life working and searching for things that would not last forever? Like Zacchaeus, we should not be so content with temporal things around us since they only satisfy us temporarily; but rather we should come out of that "deceptive satisfaction" and look for Jesus who is the true fulfillment of our hearts. As Zacchaeus climbed on the tree, we too need to "climb" above the allurements of this temporal world so that we would be able to see Jesus more clearly. At first, Zacchaeus just desired to see the face of Jesus; but when he saw Jesus, he got more than what he could imagine. Let us get beyond any earthly illusions which prevent us to see Jesus who always searches for us, who knows us by name, and who loves staying in our hearts. *Fr. Joe Pham*

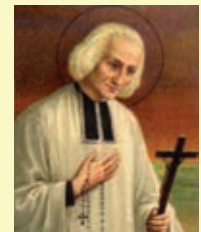

New Jersey Independent Victims Compensation Program



The Diocese of Camden – along with the other Roman Catholic dioceses in New Jersey – has established an Independent Victim Compensation Program (IVCP) to compensate those who, as children or young adults, were sexually abused by a priest of the Diocese.

The IVCP is independently administered by experienced victim compensation experts Kenneth R. Feinberg and Camille S. Biros.

The IVCP will handle the submission, evaluation and resolution of individual claims, and operates independently of the Diocese or any church-affiliated institution. The administrators of the IVCP have complete autonomy to determine the eligibility of a claim with the guidelines of the established Protocol. The amount of compensation for those who make a claim will be independently determined by the IVCP administrators. All victims – no matter when the abuse occurred – are eligible to participate, and all matters will be handled confidentially.

Victims of clergy sexual abuse of a minor can begin the process of utilizing the program by going to www.njdiocesesivcp.com and reviewing the protocol for submitting a claim.

Bishop Sullivan strongly encourages anyone who was sexually victimized by a priest of the Diocese to participate in the IVCP, and has asked that anyone who knows of someone who was abused to contact them so that they are aware of the IVCP and can participate in it.

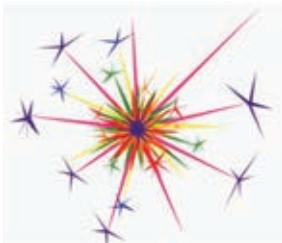
