Ignite: Grades 7 & 8

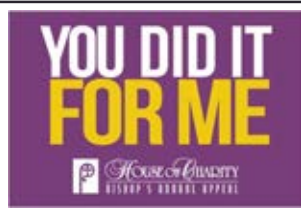
