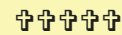

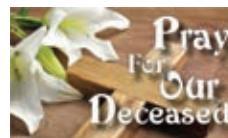

This week reminds us of the Anniversary of the Supreme Court decision, Roe vs. Wade (1973), which legalized abortion in our country. In responding to this noble call, our parish will hold a Mass for Life, sponsored by our Knights of Columbus on Thursday, January 23rd at 7:00 PM at St. Margaret Church . However, the reality is that the culture of death is not a solution at all; it is a destruction of life. Life itself is created and given by God, the Creator of all life. The fact is that, even with the advances in science and technology in today’s world, human beings still cannot create or even restore a “dead flower” to life. God must have a reason when He creates life. He must also have a reason to keep life in some circumstances, even when defined wrongly as “no quality of life”. The act of abortion or euthanasia is intrinsically evil which means evil in itself, since it is violating the Supreme Authority and Holy Will of the Creator. Life itself is a supreme gift given by God, life is always better than no life at all, as St. Paul said: “I consider that what we suffer at this present time cannot be compared at all with the glory that is going to be revealed to us.” (Romans 8:18).
