Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



In the beginning of the Gospel today, Jesus said to his disciples: “You are the salt of the earth. But if salt loses its taste, with what can it be seasoned?” This saying is a reminder of the very purpose of our lives on earth.

As the purpose of salt is for seasoning, our purpose of life is to know God as our creator and redeemer, to love God in others, and to live God in our lives. To know God should be both: “knowing by the head and by the heart as well. An atheist person would be so knowledgeable of the scriptures and theology; but still does not believe or have faith in God at all. Everyday we can get to know God and recognize his power in the universe, in sunrise and sunset, in the laws of nature, and in new births of infants. Everyday we can experience God’s presence and working in our lives and in the lives of others, in worldly events and in individual’s circumstances. This is exactly the way that God wants us to know Him: He is all in all.

Also, to love God means loving others by recognizing the image and likeness of God in them. How would one hate the image and likeness of God and in the meantime love God? Our very purpose of life is not to “kill” but to heal, not to revenge but to reconcile, not to behold hatred but love; otherwise “the salt will lose its taste and become useless”.

Finally, God created us with the purpose that we would live in him and he in us, a loving union between God and men. Living separately from God, one would lose the very purpose of his or her life, and the consequence is losing God for all eternity. Remember we are “dusts and unto dusts we shall return”. Remember our earthly life has value and meaning only when we truly live out the very purpose of life which designed by our creator. In this way, we are truly the “salt of the earth and the lamp set on stand”. *Fr. Joe Pham.*
