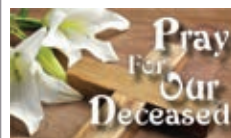

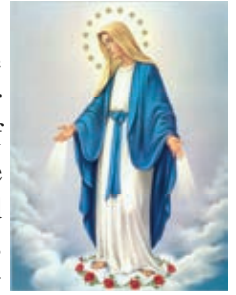

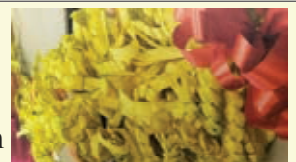

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



Today's Gospel tells us about the Transfiguration of our Lord Jesus Christ up on the mountain. The Transfiguration occurred before Jesus' passion in order to serve as a "reinforcement" for the faith of His disciples, especially for Peter, James, and John who witnessed the "Glorious Jesus". Before His suffering and death, Jesus wanted to give Peter, John, and James a glimpse of His heavenly glory, and a taste of being in His divine presence so that, in time of trial, they might still be faithful to the end. When witnessing the glorious Christ, Peter was so over excited about the heavenly light, and also the delightfulness of being in the presence of the "glorious Jesus" that he did not know what he was saying: "Lord, it is good that we are here. If you wish, I will make three tents here, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah". Instead of responding to Peter's question, Jesus told Peter and the other disciples: "Let us come down from the mountain and build the three crosses for yourselves first". Like Jesus who has to undergo "First Friday" first in order to be glorified, they too, in order to be with the glorified Jesus, had to come down the mountain to face the trial of their daily lives and carry their crosses upward to "the Easter mountain" where the glorious Jesus is waiting for them. Let us follow Jesus' footsteps by carrying our own crosses willingly whether they are physical, mental, or moral crosses, up to the "mountain of eternal life and happiness". Sometimes, this journey seems like a long, rough, crooked, or steep journey; but if we endure to reach the "mountain top", the glorious Jesus will be up there for us, he will embrace us and say: "Well done my good and faithful servant, come in to my Father's house prepared for you". -Fr. Joe Pham

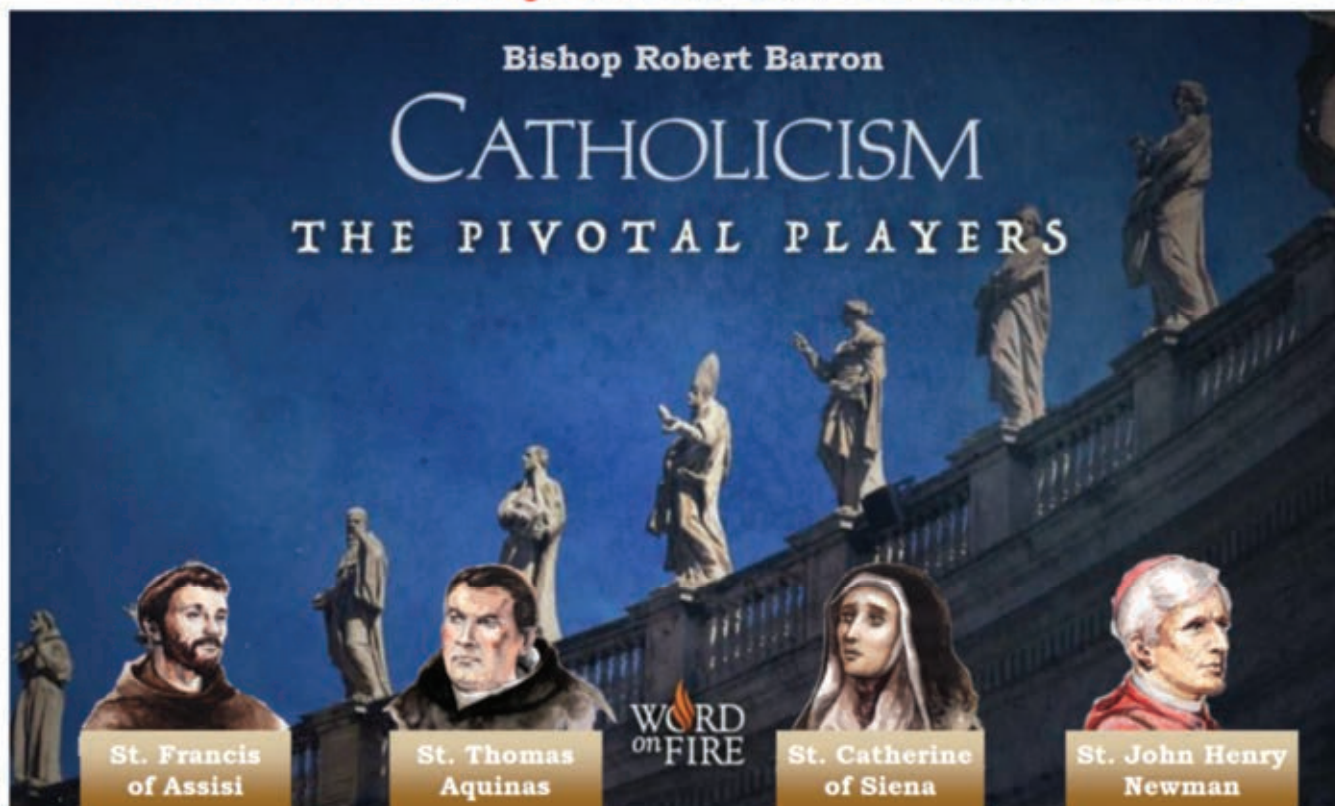
