Dear Brothers and Sisters,



Today with the whole Church, we celebrate Palm Sunday which is marking the beginning of Holy Week. We commemorate the entrance of Jesus Christ into Jerusalem to fulfill the redemptive mission entrusted to him by his Father. When entering Jerusalem, the large crowd of people took trees, branches, and even their cloaks spreading them on the ground as signs of welcoming, praising, and glorifying Jesus as their Lord and their King. However, the next day, the same people were screaming aloud: “crucify him, crucify him”. This is how humanity has treated Jesus, their loving God, from the beginning of creation until now. Indeed, very often we find ourselves not much different from the crowd above, that is, we praise Jesus, we glorify Him on weekly Sunday worship; but the next day we “crucify him” by the way we live our lives and the way we treat others. During this Holy Week, Jesus invites each one of us come: “To taste and see the loving mercy of God”. He invites us to take part in his passion, to be touched by his suffering, and to be healed by his death on the cross so that his suffering and death would not be “wasted”. As we enter into “Jerusalem” on Palm Sunday, let us stay there with our suffering Jesus on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday. Let us come to be part of the Last Supper with our Lord at the Eucharistic Table, let us be there at the foot of the cross to receive our Lord’s redemptive blood pouring out upon us, let us stay at the tomb for the vigil of our Lord’s resurrection. “Were you there when they crucified Our Lord?”
