Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



The words of St. Peter in today's Second Reading give us, as faithful followers of Christ, strength and courage to embrace any adversity, struggle, or suffering which comes into our lives: "Beloved: Sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts. Always be ready to give an explanation to anyone who asks you for a reason for your hope. For it is better to suffer for doing good, if that be the will of God, than to do evil." Keep this in mind, St. Peter does not encourage us to suffer for the sake of suffering, instead, he asks us to do the will of God, to live the will of God even if we have to suffer it. By doing this, we suffer with Jesus, we would be victors like Christ and not victims. Indeed, it is a joy, a privilege to suffer with Christ, in Christ, and for Christ. Since whatever we have to endure in this life, someday it will be gone—whereas the glory promised by Jesus will be granted us for all eternity. However, it is easier said than done. "How am I able to accept the will of God when things go astray, my future is uncertain, health is threatened, job is at stake, etc." Remember that we do not do it alone, Jesus does not abandon us, he is with us, in us, and accompanying us on this earthly journey. As the words of Jesus in today's Gospel affirm us: "I will not leave you orphans—I will come to you. In a little while the world will no longer see me, but you will see me, because I live and you will live. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always." Jesus would never depart from us even when he is not physically present to us. He asked the Father to send the Holy Spirit to protect us, to "usher" us on this earthly journey. Let our faith help us overcome any difficulties and doubts. Let our eyes be fixed upon the heavenly glory promised us who share in Christ's sufferings. Let us never forget the indwelling of God within us, God-with-us. -Fr. Joe Pham
