Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



As we are still on the road to recovery from the pandemic COVID-19, challenges and burdens are still ahead of us. Therefore, stress, frustration, and even fear seem to be inevitable. Some are struggling to find work to support families, some are still recovering from sickness, or trying to cope with the loss of loved ones, these things eventually would drain our bodies and spirits if not even extinguish the flames of our hope and love for life. As people of faith and followers of Christ, we should not let our bodies and spirits be dragged down by these earthly adversities. We should learn a lesson from the Old Testament of how God delivered the Israelite people from slavery to freedom, from hungry and thirsty to the land full of honey and milk. We should learn from Abraham and Moses unfailing trust and submissive faith in God. By placing their total trust and faith in God, they were able to overcome all adversities and challenges which came into their lives and, at last, accomplished the divine missions entrusted to them.

You and I also have a unique divine mission to carry out in this life. This mission was sown in our lives from the very beginning of our being as Jesus described in today's Gospel:

A sower went out to sow. And as he sowed, some seed fell on the path, and birds came and ate it up. Some fell on rocky ground, where it had little soil. It sprang up at once because the soil was not deep, and when the sun rose it was scorched, and it withered for lack of roots. Some fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked it. But some seed fell on rich soil, and produced fruit, a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold.

What kind of soil are we? The seed of faith was sown in our hearts and souls as a divine power to assist us to accomplish our God-entrusted missions. In order to produce a fruitful harvest, we must constantly cultivate and enrich our soil through the Sacraments and prayers. - Those who are at **HIGH RISK FOR CONTRACTING COVID-19 SHOULD STAY HOME**.

- The elderly and families with young children (who may find it difficult to maintain a six-foot distance from others) are encouraged to stay home.

- **The faithful should wear cloth face coverings** when in public, including when they come to church. Young children under the age of 2, anyone who has trouble breathing, or anyone otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance does not need to wear a face covering.
- The faithful should maintain a 6-foot distance from each other at all times except members of a single household.
