Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



All three readings today are signifying the Holy Eucharist which we gather together every Sunday to celebrate as Church. From the first reading of the Prophet Isaiah: “Thus says the Lord: All you who are thirsty, come to the water! You who have no money, come, receive grain and eat; come, without paying and without cost, drink wine and milk!” Indeed, the Eucharist is offered to us “freely”, it is already “paid” by the sacrifice of Christ, all we need to do is come and receive it. Instinctively each one of us long to live forever, we long to be happy forever, and we long to be healthy forever; however nothing in this world can fulfill these longings. Only the Holy Eucharist, the “Bread” of life, can satisfy our hunger, only this “Bread” can fulfill the eternal longings in our hearts. Meanwhile, St. Paul also said in the second reading: “What will separate us from the love of Christ? Will anguish, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or the sword? For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor present things, nor future things, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord”. What a powerful statement that St. Paul used to describe the kind of union between God and us in the Holy Eucharist. Indeed if we are united with God through “eating his flesh and drinking his blood”, then nothing can separate us from that divine intimate union. Finally the Gospel also reinforces the “effect” of the Eucharist: “They all ate and were satisfied, and they picked up the fragments left over- twelve wicker baskets full”. The implication of this statement is that when Jesus feeds us with his “Bread”, we will be fully satisfied and filled with “overflowing” of blessings. Let us come to the altar to receive the gift freely given to us. Fr. Joe Pham.

- **St. John Vianney** Saturday Vigil Mass: 6:00 pm
Sunday Mass: 11:30 am
- For the time being, those, **who were used to attending Mass at St. John Vianney, are encouraged to attend Mass at St. Margaret Church** so that **seats can be saved** for those who have difficulty driving.
- The **Dispensation** for the faithful from the obligation to participate in Mass on Sundays and Holy Days still remains in **EFFECT**.
- Those who are at **HIGH RISK FOR CONTRACTING COVID-19 SHOULD STAY HOME**.
- **A Mass will be live-streamed** each weekend for those who are unable to come to church due to health reasons or to capacity restrictions. (Time will be determined).
- The elderly and families with young children (who may find it difficult to maintain a six-foot distance from others) are encouraged to stay home.
- **Holy Communion will be distributed on Sundays at St. Margaret Church at 11:45 AM for those who watch Mass on Live-Stream** and would like to receive Holy Communion.
- **The faithful should wear cloth face coverings** when in public, including when they come to church. Young children under the age of 2, anyone who has trouble breathing, or anyone otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance does not need to wear a face covering.
- The faithful should maintain a 6-foot distance from each other at all times except members of a single household.
