# My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In today's Gospel, Jesus spoke in parables to describe the kingdom of heaven. He used the parables because the kingdom of heaven is not a "place" here or there; but rather it is a "state of being". When Jesus entered the world, he brought with him the kingdom of God; therefore the kingdom of God is "already here but not yet", not yet come to its "fullness" until the end of time. When Jesus comes the second time, he will bring the kingdom of heaven to its completion.

At first, Jesus gave the parable of the "Wheat and the Weeds" to describe his mercy and patient endurance toward sinners (the weeds): "His slave said to him, do you want us to go and pull them up? He replied: No, if you pull up the weeds you might uproot the wheat along with them. Let them grow together until harvest". Jesus always gives us a chance to change, to turn around. He is slow to condemn but quick in showing mercy, he hates sin but loves sinners. Thus; the kingdom of heaven is the kingdom of mercy and forgiveness.

Furthermore, following the parable of the "Wheat and the Weeds", Jesus continued speaking of two more parables to imply another aspect of the kingdom of heaven: "The parables of the mustard seed and the yeast". These two parables signify the "seed or the yeast" of faith was planted within us at our Baptism. In other words, the kingdom of heaven is with us, in us, which needs to be "nurtured and grown". It is "already here but not yet", it is a process of "becoming" and finally "actualized" within us.

Since God's patience and mercy as well as the "seed" of faith planted within us, the kingdom of heaven is not a "place" to enter but rather a "mission" to accomplish, it is not in God's "hand" but in our "hands". Fr. Joe Pham.

- For the time being, those, who were used to attending Mass at St. John Vianney, are encouraged to attend Mass at St. Margaret Church so that seats can be saved for those who have difficulty driving.
- The <u>Dispensation</u> for the faithful from the obligation to participate in Mass on Sundays and Holy Days still remains in **EFFECT.**
- Those who are at HIGH RISK FOR CONTRACTING COVID-19 SHOULD STAY HOME.
- A Mass will be live-streamed each weekend for those who are unable to come to church due to health reasons or to capacity restrictions. (Time will be determined).
- The elderly and families with young children (who may find it difficult to maintain a six-foot distance from others) are encouraged to stay home.
- Holy Communion will be distributed on Sundays at St. Margaret Church at 11:45 AM for those who watch Mass on Live-Stream and would like to receive Holy Communion.
- The faithful should wear cloth face coverings when in public, including when they come to church. Young children under the age of 2, anyone who has trouble breathing, or anyone otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance does not need to wear a face covering.
- The faithful should maintain a 6-foot distance from each other at all times except members of a single household.
