Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



The parable in today's Gospel implies two "groups" of Christians. The first one is the "invited" or the "baptized" who are not practicing or living their faith: "The kingdom of heaven may be likened to a king who gave a wedding feast for his son. He dispatched his servants to summon the invited guests to the feast, but they refused to come".

These are the people who were baptized and so are "invited" to come to the Eucharistic Banquet offered on the Altar every Sunday but they refuse to come. They disregard the invitation from their "Savior", they don't take it as an honor or a privilege or consider it as a priority. They are indeed the chosen ones, the ones who are set apart to be his own, the ones who are destined to be heirs of his "kingdom". What a great mistake for those who turn down the invitation of the eternal Banquet.

The second "group" are the ones who were baptized and are practicing or living their faith, the ones who attend the Eucharistic Banquet regularly. However, when coming to the Eucharistic Table, they fail to "dress" appropriately, the "appropriate disposition of heart": "But when the king came in to meet the guests, he saw a man there not dressed in a wedding garment. The king said to him, 'My friend, how is it that you came here without a wedding garment?' But he was reduced to silence. Then the king said to his attendants, "Bind his hands and feet, and cast him into the darkness outside, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth".

This second "group" is not different from the first if they don't have an "appropriate disposition of heart" at the "Banquet". These are attending the Eucharistic Banquet regularly but their hearts are far away from what they receive at the Altar. They have no mercy and compassion toward others, they receive love and forgiveness at the Altar but fail to love and to forgive. They listen to the "Word" but fail to put into practice, they recognize their wrong doing or sinful living but do not attempt to change.

Which "group" are we in? First, second, or the second but "dress appropriately"? Fr. Joe Pham.
