Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Our lives in this world are occupied with so many things which easily drain our strength and even diminish the meaning and purpose of living. St. Paul, in the second reading today, warns us not to be so caught up with this finite world but rather set our minds and desires on the “things” that last forever:

“Those using the world as not using it fully. For the world in its present form is passing away.”

Indeed, we have already experienced this in our daily lives: Our childhood is gone, our past is history, it is only a memory, our possessions come and go, and even our lives are slowly fading away everyday. Remember we were created not for this finite world but for the eternal kingdom promised by Jesus, our redeemer. Therefore, we should not let illusive things of this finite world blind us from seeing and seeking the things that last forever.

The determination of the fishermen in today’s Gospel to leave their nets and follow Jesus is a good example for all of us: “Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men.... Then they abandoned their nets and followed him.”

Jesus does not call everyone to follow him in a radical way like these disciples; however it does mean that we are not supposed to “leave our nets” behind and follow him. At the end of the day, we should let our mind be free in order to reflect on what we did or what happened during the day and try to see if anything needs to be changed for the better or anything should be discontinued for the sake of our salvation.

Let us take advantage of the time God has given us in this life and not work for the rotten fruit but for the bread of life eternal. Fr. Joe Pham.

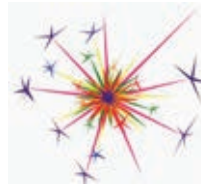

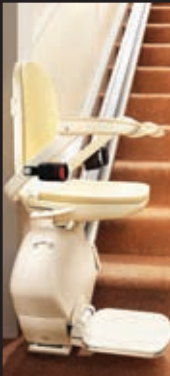
