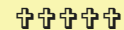

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



On Friday March 19th, the whole church will celebrate the Feast of St. Joseph, the Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the foster father of Jesus. Traditionally, this Feast was celebrated since the end of the 10th century and declared “Patron Saint of the Universal Church” in 1870 by Blessed Pope Pius IX. Later, Pope Pius XII proposed him as the “Patron of Workers”. On December 8th, 2020, Pope Francis promulgated a “**Year of Saint Joseph**” to commemorate the 150th Anniversary of Pope Pius IX’s placing the Universal Church under the patronage of Saint Joseph.

We don’t have much information about St. Joseph in the Biblical text. However, according to Scripture, St. Joseph was chosen by God, just like the Blessed Virgin Mary, to cooperate with God in His salvific plan for humanity. He was chosen to be the spouse of Mary and the foster father of Jesus Christ. He was known for his righteousness because he did not want to expose Mary to shame and to the law which would have led her to be stoned to death due to “adultery”.

Like Mary, St. Joseph was totally obedient to God’s will for him by receiving Mary and her child, Jesus, in to his care. He raised and nurtured Jesus through his hard labor as a carpenter. For this reason, He truly deserved to be called the Patron Saint of the Universal Church who would defend and protect the Church in time of difficulty as he protected Jesus when King Herod tried to kill the Infant Jesus. He would seek out the lost sheep and bring them back to the Church as he searched for the “lost Jesus” in the temple.

Husbands and fathers should look up to St. Joseph for guidance and learn from His righteousness and faithfulness. Husbands and fathers should cooperate with God’s will to nurture and care for the “domestic churches” entrusted to them. They are called to be providers, protectors, and teachers of the faith in their families. They are called to be righteous in words and deeds and to be faithful in good time and in bad, in sickness and in health. May St. Joseph help us to live righteously and faithfully in the eyes of God. - Fr. Joe Pham.

UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR THE DISTRICT OF NEW JERSEY

In re The Diocese of Camden, New Jersey
Case No. 20-21257 (JNP)

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on October 1, 2020, The Diocese of Camden, New Jersey, (the “Diocese”) filed for protection under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code.

The Bankruptcy Court has established June 30, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time) as the deadline to file proofs of claim against the Diocese (the “Bar Date”).
