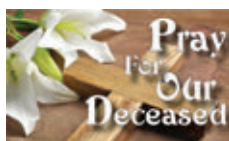

After the resurrection, the Risen Christ had appeared to his disciple several times in order to affirm them of his resurrection. In today's Gospel, Jesus appeared to the disciples again and even invited them to touch his hands and feet to clear out any doubt in their minds.

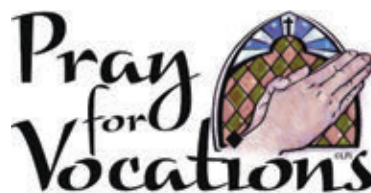
