Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



As we gather together to celebrate Pentecost Sunday, it reminds us of the day that the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles to empower them to proclaim fearlessly the Good News to all “nations”. The word “Pentecost” from Greek means “manifestation”. The Holy Spirit manifested the Church to the whole world. On Good Friday, the Church was born from the wounded side of the crucified Jesus; but not yet being manifested to the whole world until the day of Pentecost.

When the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles in the form of tongues of fire, their fear of the Jews was gone. They began to preach publically about Jesus crucified in different languages that everyone from various races and tongues was able to understand. One of the main reasons for Pentecost was that the Holy Spirit would enable the Apostles to communicate the Good News of salvation to all people from different races, languages, and cultures.

As we know language is an essential means in communication, it is a bridge to connect heart to heart, and mind to mind. There are so many different languages spoken in the world and, in order to understand them, we have no choice but to learn them. However, there is a language that everyone in the world would understand regardless of race and culture, a language that is not acquired from learning. It does not come from written form of letters, characters, or symbols, but it is from the heart, the language of love. The problem of violence, destruction, separation, hatred, and suffering in today’s world and in our own families, is indeed caused by people who speak their own “selfish languages”, the languages that speak only to and for themselves but not to and for others: “me, my, mine,” and not, “you, your, yours”.

As Easter people, the people of faith, hope, and love, let us pray that the Holy Spirit would empower us to speak the language that everyone in our families and in our world can relate and understand. *Fr. Joe Pham*

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on October 1, 2020, The Diocese of Camden, New Jersey, (the “**Diocese**”) filed for protection under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code.

The Bankruptcy Court has established June 30, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time) as the deadline to file proofs of claim against the Diocese (the “Bar Date**”).**

If you have a claim against the Diocese including, without limitation, a claim related to sexual abuse committed by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim on or before the Bar Date with Prime Clerk, the appointed Claims Agent.

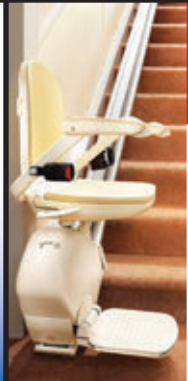
