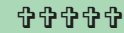

In today's Gospel, Jesus sent his disciples in pairs to towns and villages and gave them the authority over unclean spirits: "The Twelve drove out many demons, and they anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them". Their mission was to heal body and soul.

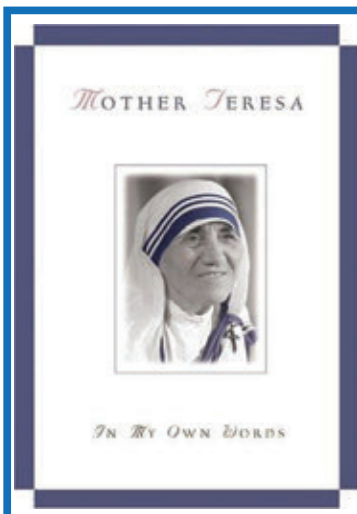

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Due to the COVID-19, our parish has been offering Masses LIVE STREAMED on our Facebook page for over a year now. In the beginning of the Pandemic, we were LIVE STREAMING three Masses per week; but now we LIVE STREAM only one Mass (4:00 PM Saturday). Even though we are now back to normality, we still need to continue LIVE STREAMING Mass for the spiritual well-being of the elderly, the sick, and homebound parishioners. Therefore, we are putting a plan in place to mount a professional camera in our church for better picture and sound quality.

We have received price quotes from Comcast and Verizon for the required hi-speed internet connection in the church, as well as for the camera, hardware, and installation prices. We are looking at a cost of **around \$10,000** to get us up and running, and that includes a year of monthly cable costs. If this camera is installed, it can open up many opportunities to LIVE STREAM other liturgical celebrations including weddings, funerals, first Communions, Confirmations, graduation ceremonies, parish missions, etc.

Our parish is falling behind most of the other parishes in the diocese in terms of technology. We have been LIVE STREAMING from a **Smartphone and phone data** up to this point. However, we cannot continue LIVE STREAMING from a Smartphone long term; the above mentioned camera system is really needed in order to provide the spiritual need for our sick and homebound parishioners. Surely they feel more comfortable when they watch a Mass celebrated from their home parish.
