Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Sparks: grades 3-5

Szolack Center from 5:30-6:30 PM (masks are optional but strongly recommended for anyone unvaccinated, we will have hand sanitizer available and will practice social distancing). This will give people time to arrive after the 4PM Mass at St. Margaret Church. The first meeting will take place on Sunday, September 13th. Meetings will include prayer, snacks, icebreakers and energizers, and small and large group activities, all in the context of faith and fun. Ignite members will have opportunities for service projects and volunteer work throughout the year.



Ablaze: grades 9-12

Ablaze is the group for those in 9th-12th grade. Ablaze meets on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of the month beginning September 19th at St. John Vianney in the Fr. Szolack Center from 5:30-6:30 PM (masks are optional but strongly recommended for anyone unvaccinated, we will have hand sanitizer available and will practice social distancing). 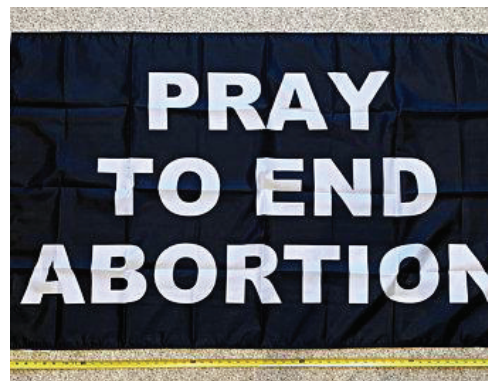
