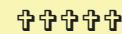

### **S3030/A4848 - The Reproductive Freedom Act**

In October 2020, S3030/A4848 "The Reproductive Freedom Act" (RFA) (an oxymoron in light of how children die because of it) was introduced in the New Jersey Legislature. If passed, this legislation would expand New Jersey's already permissive abortion laws.

On October 5, 2020, the Catholic Bishops of New Jersey issued a statement opposing the legislation and reaffirmed the Catholic Church's commitment to protect to the dignity of all life from conception to natural death.

At this time, the legislature has not advanced S3030/A4848. The New Jersey Catholic Conference (NJCC) is closely monitoring the situation and will send out an action alert once we know when the bill will move.

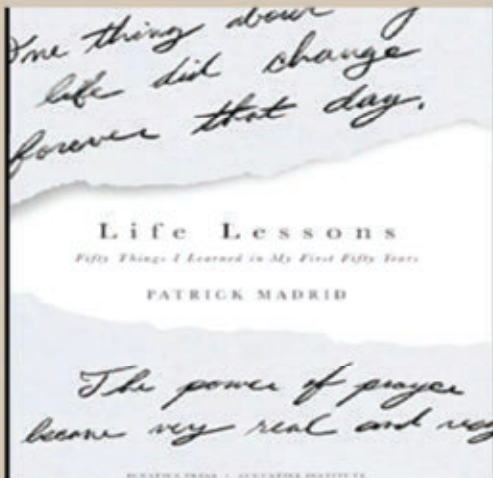
