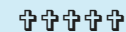

PRO-LIFE

Catholic Doctrine states that *"Human life is sacred because from its beginning it involves the creative action of God and it remains for ever in a special relationship with the Creator, who is its sole end. God alone is the Lord of life from its beginning until its end: no one can under any circumstance claim for himself the right directly to destroy an innocent human being"* ("Donum vitae," 5).



The *NJ Reproductive Freedom Act* is a radical NJ abortion bill being pushed to preempt the possibility of a US Supreme Court overturning of the 1973 *Roe v. Wade* Decision on **12/1/21** through the *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* case. This challenge is to Mississippi's law restricting most abortions after 15 weeks of pregnancy, where the court will decide the question of whether all state abortion bans pre-viability are unconstitutional. **"Viability"** is the court's legal standard from 1973, regarded as *the point at which an unborn child can survive outside the womb*.

This NJ Act (Gov. Murphy wants it passed by 12/2021) mandates:

- abortions by non-physicians in an office setting, past 14 weeks of pregnancy, (which was just approved by the NJ Board of Medical Examiners).
- making all abortions, including late term abortions *and infanticide*, a "fundamental right." Also exempts prosecution for those who commit infanticide.
- babies capable of pain having no rights at any stage of pregnancy, *even if viable and at full term*.
- deleting the "Parental Notification for Abortion Act" (for minors getting parental consent for an abortion), and restraining future legislatures from passing laws, against parental notification of a minor's abortion, even if NJ voters are against it.
- subverts (invalidates, prohibits...) NJ voters from deciding what abortion laws can be enacted should *Roe v Wade* be overturned

Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization could impact the fate of millions of preborn children and their mothers with U. S. Supreme Court oral arguments set for 12/1/21. Please register at prayfordobbs.com to virtually join thousands of Catholics & Protestants across our country praying that the U.S. Supreme Court uphold the Mississippi law protecting life & affirming Women's health by banning abortion after 15 weeks gestation when "viability" (baby is capable of living outside the mothers womb) occurs. Viability was the measure used originally by *Roe v. Wade* & *Planned Parenthood v. Casey*, which has no basis in current medical research of fetal development, nor constitutional text or history.

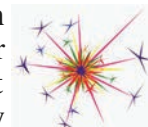
