Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



This Sunday is Gaudete Sunday, Rejoice Sunday. In the Second Reading, St. Paul tells us: “Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus....”

However, how can I rejoice while my loved one is gone? How can I rejoice while I am jobless? How can I rejoice while there are so many problems arisen in my marriage and my family? 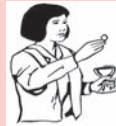
