Today, with the whole Church, we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. The Holy Family is Holy because Jesus is God; however "Holiness" is also extended to those who do the will of God as well. The "yes" to God's will made



Mary the mother of God and the obedience of Joseph to God's "command" in his dream, made him the foster father of God. Indeed, all members of the Holy Family: Jesus, Mary and Joseph, did the will of God, the Father. 
