

# Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

This week reminds us of the Anniversary of the Supreme Court decision, Roe vs. Wade (1973), which legalized abortion in our country. Encountering this Anniversary, the Church in the United States is calling for a "Day of Prayer" for the legal protection of unborn children. Meetings will include prayer, snacks, icebreakers and energizers, discussions and activities, all in the context of faith and fun. 
