**Fasting** - All persons 18 years of age and older, up to and including their 59th birthday, are bound to fast by limiting themselves to a single full meal on **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday**, while the other two meals are to be light.

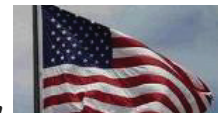

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



On Wednesday we will celebrate Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the Lenten Season. Although Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of obligation; it is a “Holy Day of Restoration”. The ashes remind us of who we are, we are mortal, we are sinners, we are dust and unto dust we shall return.

When we receive the ashes, the minister makes the sign of the cross on our foreheads by saying “repent and believe in the Gospel”. Repent and believe in the Gospel is the only way to transform our mortality into immortality, the only way to change our “nothingness” into “preciousness”, and the only way to change our eternal damnation into eternal beatific vision of God in heaven.

Ash Wednesday helps us to be in touch with our sinfulness and weaknesses so that we would have in our hearts a longing to change for a better priest, religious, husband, wife, mom, dad, son, daughter, brother, sister, and neighbor. 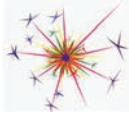
**Blessed Mother Statue**

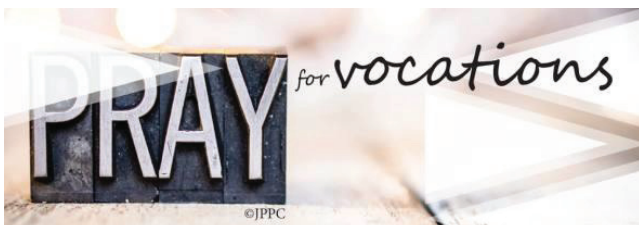

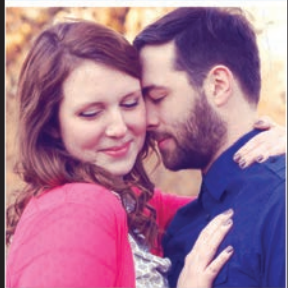
