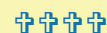

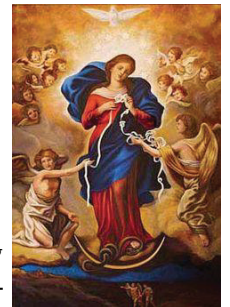
#### **February 17th, 2022 (Thursday) - Virtual Faith-Based Event**

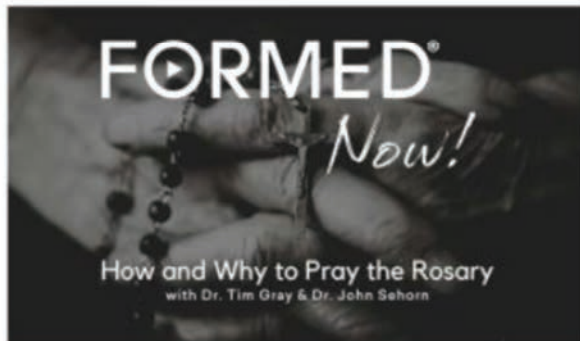
