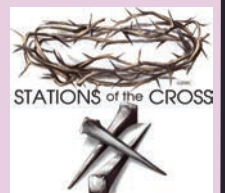

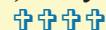

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,



Today's Gospel tells us about the Transfiguration of our Lord Jesus Christ up on the mountain. The Transfiguration occurred before Jesus' passion in order to serve as a "reinforcement" for the faith of His disciples, especially for Peter, James, and John who witnessed the "Glorious Jesus".

Before His suffering and death, Jesus wanted to give Peter, John, and James a glimpse of His heavenly glory, and a taste of being in His divine presence so that, in time of trial, they might still be faithful to the end.

When witnessing the glorious Christ, Peter was so over ecstatic about the heavenly light and also, being in the presence of the "glorious Jesus", it blew his mind off to the point that he did not know what he was saying: "Lord, it is good that we are here. If you wish, I will make three tents here, one for you, one for Moses, and one for Elijah". Instead of responding to Peter's question, Jesus told Peter and the other disciples: "Let us come down from the mountain" and build the three "crosses" for yourselves first.

First, they must come "down the mountain" and carry their crosses upward to the "Transfigured mountain" in order to stay up there forever. Let us carry our crosses, whether they are physical, mental, or moral crosses, up to the "Transfigured Mountain". This journey will sometimes be a long, rough, crooked, or steep journey; but when reaching the "mountain top", the glorious Jesus will be up there waiting for us. He will embrace us and say: "Well done my good and faithful servant, come to my Father's house prepared for you".

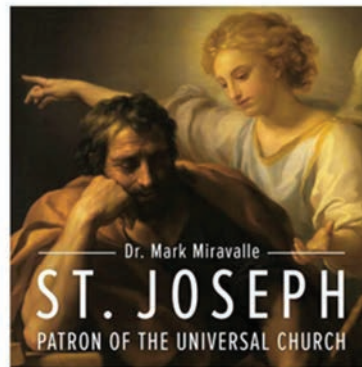


