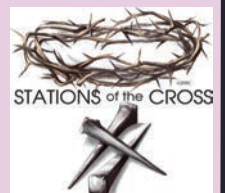

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



As we are already half way into the Lenten Season, we are reminded by today's Gospel: "Sir, leave it for this year also, and I shall cultivate the ground around it and fertilize it; it may bear fruit in the future. If not you can cut it down." This parable of the "fig tree" signifies God's loving care and patience. He is not quick to condemn but rather always gives us a second chance to change, to convert, and to be redeemed. Imagine if Jesus did not have patience, the whole world would be gone now.

The more we reflect upon Jesus's loving patience, the more we find ourselves so "embarrassed and guilty": "embarrassed and guilty" because God is super patient with us through the Sacrament of Penance; whereas we have so little patience for others if not at all. Thanks be to Jesus for His tireless patience.

In the meantime, we must be conscious of the "hour" which may come to us at anytime and, when it comes, it would be too late to change. It is not because Jesus's patience is limited but rather because our time on this earthly journey is limited. It would never be too late if one recognizes the need to change, to convert, to refocus, or to grow, and do it. If God is so patient with us and always gives us a second chance, we too need to be more patient with others by giving them a second chance to change and grow. Remember God's mercy and forgiveness does not work with "contradiction" as we learn it from the "Our Father Prayer": "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us."

Let us take this time to examine our lives to see what needs to be corrected, changed, or grown. Meanwhile, let us practice our charity as atonement for our sins by being more patient, loving, caring, and forgiving, so that our loved ones or others would have a second chance during this "season of following Jesus' footsteps to Calvary". *Fr.
