Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Today's Gospel tells us the story of the "Prodigal Son" which signifies the mercy of God the Father for humanity. The moral meaning in this story is not so much about the repentant son; but rather it is about the merciful attribute of the father. When the first son realized that the celebration was for the return of his younger brother, he was so upset and angry with his father. Disappointed a little but gently the father explained the reason for the celebration to him:

"My son, you are here with me always; everything I have is yours. But now we must celebrate and rejoice, because your brother was dead and has come to life again; he was lost and has been found."

The two sons have two different perceptions about their father, for the older son, his father was a "strict and legalistic man"; therefore he expected his father to punish his younger brother for breaking the "family law" instead of celebrating. However, the younger son perceived his father as a loving and forgiving father and that was the reason for him to come back.

What perceptions do we have about our God the Father? God is strict and legalistic, the law is the law, law breakers must be punished. God is full of mercy and compassion, always ready to forgive. For some still worship God and practice their faith legalistically such as going to Sunday Mass because of "obligation" instead of recognizing the need of eternal salvation. Not breaking the Ten Commandments due to "fear" of punishment rather than due to the love of God and neighbor. Receiving the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Communion, Confirmation, Matrimony, just for the sake of "tradition or celebration/ceremony" rather than for the sake of strong faith in God, assured hope in eternal life, and true love of God and neighbor. God does not want us to approach Him this way. He does not want us to perceive Him as the older son perceived his father. God wants us to treat Him as a merciful Father who is always waiting at the "gate" for our return. Waiting to restore our dignity as His children which was lost through sin, and waiting to celebrate our new life in Him. This is the "kind" of God in which we believe and worship. *Fr. Joe Pham*
