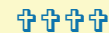

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,



Today with the whole Church, we celebrate Palm Sunday, the Passion of the Lord Jesus Christ which commemorates His entrance into Jerusalem. When the hour had come to fulfill the redemptive mission entrusted to Jesus by His Father, Jesus entered Jerusalem to suffer and die for the salvation of humanity.

When entering Jerusalem, the crowd of people took tree branches, and even their cloaks spreading them on the ground as signs of welcoming, praising, and glorifying Jesus as the Son of David and their King. The next day, the same crowd was screaming aloud: “crucify him, crucify him”. This is how humanity has treated Jesus, their loving God, from the beginning of creation until now.

Very often we find ourselves not much different from the crowd above, that is, we praise Jesus, we glorify Him on our weekly Sunday worship; but the next day we “crucify him” by the way we live our lives and the way we treat others. During this Holy Week, Jesus invites each one of us: “To taste and see the loving mercy of God”, he invites us to partake in His Passion for the sake of our salvation so that His suffering would not be “wasted”. Indeed, the thing that hurts Jesus the most is not about the physical pain; but rather the rejection of His loving passion offered for the forgiveness of sins.

As we enter into “Jerusalem” on Palm Sunday, let us stay there with our suffering Jesus on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday, let us see for ourselves how much He loves us by walking with Him to Calvary, “Were you there when they crucified Our Lord?”
